Among those who returned, the lowest basic Divine Power was 50 points. With the amplification from their Divine Domain World and the Eternity series abilities, this could reach two to three hundred. The one with the highest basic Divine Power had 300 points, and their final amplified Divine Power reached a staggering 900 points—truly in a class of their own.

Chen Mo's current final Divine Power, even after amplification, was only 640 points.

If he didn't have the Chaotic Primordial Pearl, this person's Divine Power would be enough to completely suppress him, rendering him unable to exert any of his own strength.

This expert with the highest Divine Power, however, had an exceedingly ordinary appearance; he looked like an ordinary person, the type who would easily be lost in a crowd. He wore a suit of leather armor, holding a longbow in his hand, his class being a ranged physical damage dealer.

"Ling Yue, why did you suddenly call us all back? The front line has completely collapsed; we can't waste a second!"

Although these experts had obediently returned to the Base of the Tower as commanded, they were extremely anxious about the current situation and felt they couldn't afford to waste a single second of combat time.

Seeing this, Ling Yue wasted no time and immediately shared the information about the Chaotic Primordial Array that Chen Mo had just provided.

One look at it, and all the experts around were stunned.

"Is this the chaos-grade supreme treasure that The Heavenly Path's Hint said Chen Mo obtained?"

"This effect is truly outrageous! Unlimited integration of Divine Power? If we pool all our Divine Power, what astronomical figure would that reach?"

At these words, everyone eagerly urged Chen Mo, "Quick, Chen Mo, form the army array and let us see!"

Seeing the eager anticipation on the faces of the seniors around him, Chen Mo smiled and nodded. "No problem."

With a mental command, all of Earth's experts present with Divine Power exceeding 200 points received an invitation to join the array.

Soon, the 100-person limit was reached.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Army array formation complete! Your current army array's integrated Divine Power is 39,500 points!]

The vast majority of the 100 individuals in the array had Divine Power in the 200-300 point range, but a significant number possessed several hundred points, bringing the army array's final integrated Divine Power to a terrifying level close to 40,000 points.

Although the integrated Divine Power reached a terrifying 39,500 points, this power wouldn't further double each member's divine element. Instead, it would amplify the effects of attacks when the army array executed Army Formation Skills or when its members launched their own attacks.

But even so, the enhancement is still terrifying.

For instance, a skill that could originally only inflict damage equal to 10 times the divine element, after being amplified by 39,500 points of Divine Power, can now cause damage equal to 395,000 times the divine element.

Of course, the Divine Power of an army array would be neutralized by that of an opposing army array. How much can be neutralized depends on the Divine Power Strength of the opposing army array.

At this stage, Chen Mo's army array, formed by the Chaotic Primordial Array, is invincible within any battlefield in the first region, as long as it does not attack the opponent's foundation. After all, the most potent army array in the first region currently only has 10,000 Divine Power. This is a full 29,500 Divine Power Strength points less than Chen Mo's current army array. They are simply not on the same level.

Although the Divine Power of an army array doesn't cause a combat power nullification effect, it remains incredibly resilient.

Normally, in a Divine Power confrontation between professionals: if I have more Divine Power than you, the effects you produce will be offset by a corresponding percentage. Once I have 100 more Divine Power points than you, any ability you use will have 0% effect. This gap is insurmountable.

But the Divine Power of an army array is different. The Divine Power of an army array provides an additional buff and an additional debuff.

For instance, if both sides launch an attack with 100 divine element intensity. One side has 100 array divine power, and the other has 200 array divine power. If Divine Power amplification is fully accounted for, the attack intensity from the left side would be 10,000 divine element, and from the right, 20,000 divine element. However, array divine power from opposing army arrays will neutralize each other. Ultimately, this means the left side utilizes 0 array divine power, while the right side utilizes 100 array divine power. This means the left side's 100 divine element intensity attack receives no bonus, only dealing its original 100 divine element damage. The army array on the right, however, benefits from the remaining 100 array divine power after neutralization, launching an attack of 10,000 divine element damage.

In the end, the left army array inflicts 100 divine element damage on the right army array, while the right army array inflicts 10,000 divine element damage on the left army array.

This is the difference between the array divine power of an army array and the Divine Power of professionals. Even if the opposing army array's divine power is 100 points stronger, it won't nullify the opponent's base abilities, only their amplification effects. This allows the opponent's attacks to still produce their most basic effects.

However, this isn't very useful. After all, they are attacking you with enormous amplification bonuses, while you have no amplification effects for your attacks against them. They can obliterate you with a single strike, while you can only sting them like a mosquito, causing no significant pain or irritation. It may not seem like an absolute crush, but it is very close to it.

"39,500 Divine Power! That's an outrageous number! This is a perfect example of a Robust Army! Who could withstand this onslaught?"

Witnessing the army array's current Divine Power Strength, everyone around was dumbfounded.

"Quick, let's see how thick the army shield is!"

The thickness of an army shield is determined by the sum of the God Ability of all participating members. After deification, all attributes consolidate into divine element, while Life and Energy consolidate into God Ability. Whether you are attacked and lose Health, or use a Skill and consume Energy, it all consumes God Ability. Once your God Ability is drained, you will die.

The God Ability attribute is typically 100 times the divine element attribute. Chen Mo's current divine element attribute, after amplification, is 169,600 points, making his God Ability 16.96 million points. These 16.96 million points represent the total attribute quantity from the sum of all his life value and energy value. The others are in the same situation.

The total God Ability from these 100 individuals is nearly 1.4 billion points. The army shield's thickness also increases multiplicatively with the number of participants. With 100 participants, this thickness is amplified 100-fold, meaning their army shield's final thickness is 140 billion God Ability points. Moreover, this God Ability thickness of the army shield does not decrease when members within the army array use Skills that consume God Ability; it's effectively a completely separate Health pool.

However, if an army array includes members who have not yet undergone deification, such members will lack God Ability. Their contribution to it can only be calculated based on their life value, where 100 million life value equals just 1 point of God Ability. The attribute data from array members of this caliber is largely negligible.

Currently, Chen Mo's army array, with its God Ability shield of 140 billion, is considered exceptionally thick. After all, most people's divine element intensity isn't very high at the moment.

In a typical battle, if the Divine Power difference between two combatants isn't large, the fight can be quite slow. Take Chen Mo, for example. As a powerhouse among fifth-transition professionals, his divine element is only 169,600, but his God Ability is 16.96 million. When fighting someone of comparable

strength, if both launch attacks with an intensity of 169,600, not much damage would actually penetrate after various damage reduction effects are applied to these mutual attacks. Dealing damage equivalent to about one-tenth of a divine element unit per attack would be considered quite good.

After all, there are attack and defense calculation rules between divine elements, different from the formulas of the mortal era. The defensive capabilities of divine elements make them more resilient to damage than in mortal times. Even if one's divine element is 10 times greater than the target's, the final damage inflicted would only be about one-third of the standard divine element damage.

This is why challenging those of a higher tier after reaching the God Realm is so difficult. Because, when Divine Power is equal, even if your divine element is higher than your opponent's, inflicting damage isn't easy. It's even more challenging, practically impossible, to deal damage if your Divine Power and divine element are both lower than your opponent's.

Chapter 697: Robust Army! (Five-in-One)_5

Of course, he was going to get beaten up.

However, Chen Mo wasn't overly worried about this.

Because he wasn't a regular professional; he was the Main God of the Undead, who relied on summoned creatures to deal damage. Now, after his deification, although the calculation rules for his skills had changed, they remained exceptionally powerful.

The data for a few of his main skills were as follows:

[The Undead's Legion·Gold]

Profession: Skeleton Mage

Cooldown: 5 seconds

Effect: Consumes 1 point of God Ability to summon a number of Skeleton Monsters equal to 'Level × Profession Star Level × Divine Power'. These Skeleton Monsters are permanent. Their profession can be

self-designated from various low-tier professions, and they will be equipped with the corresponding low-tier profession's phantom weapons and skills.

The attributes of the Skeleton Monsters are linked to your divine element and God Ability, where their 'God Ability = Your God Ability × 10' and their 'divine element = Your divine element × 3'. Additionally, their attributes are enhanced by an amount equivalent to 'Your Profession Star Level × 50%' of your All Attributes.

In other words, the God Ability of the Skeleton Monsters summoned by Chen Mo is ten times his own, and their divine element is three times his own.

Based on this, the Skeleton Monsters can also receive an additional attribute bonus equivalent to half of Chen Mo's Profession Star Level. Chen Mo's current Profession Star Level is a staggering 400 stars, meaning the Skeleton Monsters gain an additional 200-fold attribute enhancement from this. This power boost was incredibly potent.

Essentially, after their attributes are boosted, the Skeleton Monsters can rival the attribute strength of a typical second-tier God Realm entity.

In other words, if Chen Mo isn't suppressed by Divine Power, he can fight opponents of higher tiers using his summons.

Of course, avoiding suppression entirely is impossible. Even if he activates the effect of the Chaos Supreme Treasure to negate percentage-based suppression, Chen Mo would still be subject to standard multiplicative suppression. Thus, fighting across tiers remains challenging.

However, fighting enemies below the second-tier God Realm is extremely easy. If an opponent's Divine Power isn't higher than his, he can even achieve a crushing victory. He could effortlessly take on millions, or even billions, of individual powerhouses with similar Divine Power, provided they aren't organized into an army array.

But if he encounters Divine Power suppression, his combat power will decrease rapidly.

Nevertheless, as long as the suppression isn't too severe, Chen Mo retains a strong counter-attack capability. After all, his summons possess extremely high attributes; even if suppressed a hundredfold, their combat effectiveness would still be substantial.

Besides The Undead's Legion, the effects of Chen Mo's other four skills also changed accordingly.

[Universal Shield·Gold]

Profession: Skeleton Mage

Level Requirement: 10

Cooldown: 30 seconds

Effect: Consumes at least 1 point of God Ability. Applies a shield to all friendly units within a radius of 'Level × Profession Star Level × Divine Power' meters. This shield has a shield point total equal to $5 \times (100 + \text{Profession Star Level}) \times \text{consumed God Ability points}$. The shield can withstand any type of damage and lasts indefinitely.

Any unit that damages an ally protected by this shield will cause the shielded ally to enter 'Frenzy', increasing their attack speed by 100%. It will also trigger 'Lightning Chain Retaliation'. The retaliation damage is equal to 'your divine element'. The unit that ultimately breaks the shield will receive fixed damage equal to 'the shield's original maximum shield points'.

If the shield shatters or is dispelled, a new shield is automatically reapplied (this effect triggers only once).

Shield points can be used as a universal consumable. They can substitute for various resource costs, such as God Ability, fighting intent value, rage value, etc. All your resource consumptions can be primarily covered by shield points (this characteristic does not apply to the casting of Universal Shield itself).

[Worshipping the God of Death·Gold]

Profession: Skeleton Mage

Level Requirement: 5

Cooldown: 60 seconds

Effect: Consumes 1 point of God Ability. Affects all summoned creatures within a radius of 'Level × Profession Star Level × Divine Power' meters, increasing their attack speed by 300%. Their attacks inflict 'Inaction' and 'Despair' on the target; these debuffs can stack.

If the summoned creatures possess a shield, their movement speed and attack speed are additionally increased by 100%, and their attacks inflict bonus damage equal to 1% of their current shield points.

While this effect is active, they gain the 'Immortal' and 'Flying' abilities.

If they die while this effect is active, they inflict a Death Curse on their killer, increasing all damage received by the killer by 5%. This curse can stack.

The Worshipping the God of Death effect is permanent, but its buffs do not stack if reapplied to the same unit.

While Worshipping the God of Death is active, each summoned creature is equipped with a 'Reaper Suit' corresponding to its profession. The level of the Reaper Suit is identical to the caster's level.

The changes to Worshipping the God of Death weren't very significant. Besides the range formula now incorporating Divine Power and the energy cost changing to God Ability, other modifications were minor.

[Endless Healing Wave-Gold]

Profession: Skeleton Mage

Level Requirement: 15

Cooldown: 10 seconds

Effect: Consumes 1 point of God Ability. Unleashes an Endless Healing Wave affecting all units within a radius of 'Level × Profession Star Level × Divine Power' meters around you. This Healing Wave jumps between units indefinitely, prioritizing unaffected units. If enemies are present, it will alternate between allies and enemies. The Healing Wave jumps every 0.005 seconds. Each time it lands on a unit, it inflicts either healing or damage.

Friendly targets are healed for an amount equal to 'your divine element × Profession Star Level × Level'. This healing also affects all other friendly units within a 500-meter radius of the primary target.

If a healed friendly target is already at full Health, the wave instead inflicts fixed damage equal to that target's maximum life value upon all units within a 500-meter radius of that full-Health target.

Chapter 698: Robust Army! (Five-in-One)_6

It inflicts damage equivalent to your "divine element x star level x Level" to enemy targets. This damaging effect also spreads to affect all enemy units within a 500-meter radius of the target unit.

If the target's Health is depleted, it inflicts area-of-effect fixed damage equivalent to the target's maximum life value. This damage affects units within a 500-meter radius of this target unit.

If the target is lost, it will rebound to the previous target and take effect again. If it continues to lose its target, it will keep rebounding to successively earlier targets until all preceding targets are exhausted.

Each time the Healing Wave jumps, its healing and damage output will increase by 1%. This effect can stack infinitely!

The Endless Healing Wave's effects haven't changed much; its healing and damage output remain considerable.

The changes to these few key Skills weren't actually very significant.

Thanks to these four Skills, as long as Chen Mo doesn't encounter enemies organized into legions within the Tower of Eternity, he can basically hold his own against any foe when venturing out alone.

Since he was already unbeatable in one-on-one combat, now that he could form an army array stronger than others, Chen Mo's combat power was naturally even more terrifying.

Seeing such a terrifying army array with nearly 40,000 Divine Power assembled, those who had just returned from the front line were eager to set off again.

"Those bastards brought out a Myriad Divine Power Army! They exploited our smaller numbers before, using that Myriad Divine Power Army to tie down many of us. Now that we have an army array with 40,000 Divine Power, let's see how they can possibly resist!"

Currently, two Myriad Divine Power Armies were contending on the front line.

Earth's side naturally also had a Myriad Divine Power Army, but forming such a large army array required a significant number of personnel for both sides.

Other, lesser army arrays wouldn't dare to even approach formations of this caliber; after all, any stray attack leaking out could easily shatter an army array with low divine power.

This resulted in the two large army arrays being tied down by each other.

This was extremely disadvantageous for the Solar System.

This was because, compared to their despicable opponents from the Yongming Star System—who possessed three Life Planets and reinforcements from numerous other Star Systems—they were severely lacking in manpower.

Now, with the Myriad Divine Power Army tying down so much of their combat strength, the situation was becoming increasingly critical.

Yet, they couldn't afford not to commit so many people to contain it. If they allowed the enemy's Myriad Divine Power Army to run rampant, the entire Divine Domain would essentially become their backyard.

After all, for a Myriad Divine Power Army, the 500-point or 1,000-point Divine Power fluctuations within the Divine Domain were almost negligible.

If your 5,000 Divine Power army array encountered a Myriad Divine Power Army, even if your army array received a 500 or 1,000 Divine Power boost from the Divine Domain, becoming a 5,500 or 6,000 Divine Power army array, while the enemy's Myriad Divine Power Army was penalized by the Divine Domain, reducing it to 9,500 or 9,000 Divine Power, they would still crush you with a 3,000 to 4,000 Divine Power advantage.

This level of overwhelming dominance allowed them to do whatever they pleased within your Divine Domain.

This was a necessary compromise. No matter how short on manpower they were, they had to form this Myriad Divine Power Army to counter the enemy's counterpart.

Of course, things were different now. They had an army array with nearly 40,000 Divine Power, completely overwhelming the opponent by 29,500 Divine Power. Shouldn't they just charge over and obliterate them!

Everyone was naturally eager and impatient to act.

Seeing how excited the seniors were, Chen Mo immediately turned to Ling Yue and said, "If there are no other critical matters to attend to, then let's head to the front line now."

After all, she is the Commander-in-Chief of this operation's command center.

"With such an army array, we don't need to worry about your safety. Chen Mo, go and join the battle. This will also free up our Myriad Divine Power Army."

After Ling Yue finished speaking, she immediately activated the Base Teleport.

The Base within the Tower could serve as a primary teleportation point, sending all professionals from their Native Land to any Divine Domain occupied by their own forces.

Without relying on the Base Teleport, one could not simply teleport between distant locations unaided.

This was because each regional block was considered an independent space. This also explained why, when the enemy attacked a Divine Domain one controlled, they didn't simply launch attacks from their own Divine Domain to bombard it from afar—thus avoiding Divine Power suppression. The simple reason was: they couldn't.

Each Divine Domain was an independent space; one could not launch an attack from one Divine Domain and have it land in another.

Similarly, one could not teleport directly from one Divine Domain to another.

One could use their Teleport ability to move anywhere within a single Divine Domain.

However, to travel from one Divine Domain to another, one had to cross the border at the point where the two Divine Domains connected.

The only ways to teleport across the entire first floor of the Tower of Eternity, traversing numerous different, independent Divine Domains, were by using specific items like Divine Realm Teleportation Stones or Base Teleportation Stones, or by utilizing the Whole Domain Teleportation ability of one's own Native Land's Tower Base. This allowed direct teleportation to any Divine Domain controlled by people from one's own Star System.

At this moment, Chen Mo's army array, wielding nearly 40,000 Divine Power, was directly air-dropped into the Divine Domain on the front line where the fighting was most intense.

Many of the top experts who had recently departed were, in fact, fighting in this very region.

With those experts holding the line within each army array, the defenders had been able to hang on a bit longer.

However, their recent departure left fewer individuals with high divine element in the army arrays. Consequently, despite little change in the array divine power, the combat effectiveness they could exert had noticeably decreased.

For a moment, the pressure was so intense they could barely breathe.

At this point, many legions were being forced to retreat while fighting, already pushed to the edge of the next Divine Domain.

If they all retreated, this Divine Domain would essentially be declared captured by the enemy.

However, conquering a Divine Domain always cost the enemy some time.

This was because after a Divine Domain was newly captured, the enemy had to spend time occupying it first.

Typically, they wouldn't immediately attack an adjacent Divine Domain. After all, without establishing a foothold in the captured Divine Domain to mitigate the negative effects of invading new enemy territory, seizing the next one would be difficult.

This was a necessary expenditure of time.

It was precisely for this reason that the Solar System had not yet completely collapsed.

However, if this situation continued, they wouldn't be able to hold out much longer.

"What should we do? We can't hold them off anymore. Why were our seniors suddenly summoned away by the commander? If they don't come back, we're going to lose this Divine Domain!"

Seeing the enemy exploit their weakened state to intensify the assault, many defenders gradually found themselves unable to hold on.

"There must be some important plan for the commander to call them back. Hang in there, maybe there's a good plan coming."

"Could it be that they're forming a special forces team to steal the enemy's Divine Domain? But if this group of top fighters is all withdrawn, we have no power to resist."

"Damn it, these guys are too aggressive in their attack, we can't withstand it, let's retreat!"

...

"You from the Solar System, stop struggling in vain! Whoever is willing to surrender right now, we can issue you the Yongming Star System Citizenship Conversion Card!"

"You're already defeated today; struggling is pointless. Your lives are your own. Living in our Yongming Star System is no worse than living in your Solar System, so why not just join us."

Seeing the morale on the Solar System side crumbling under the assault, the people from the Yongming Star System immediately made their tempting offer.

Undoubtedly, these words held a certain allure.

Upon hearing this, many from the Solar System felt a momentary impulse. They considered accepting the Stars Citizenship Conversion Card and defecting to the enemy's Star System rather than continuing such a bitter struggle.

However, their reason and loyalty suppressed this impulse.

Many retorted immediately, cursing, "Stop trying to sugar-coat your bullshit offers! We're not interested in your stinky Star System. Our Solar System has a super-genius; do you have one? Do you even know why you all joined forces today? Are you claiming to be better than our Solar System? No, it's because you're scared shitless! That's why you've mobilized so many Star Systems to besiege us! Just you wait! Once our genius enters the Tower of Eternity, you'll see what's coming!"

"Exactly! Have you ever heard of a Chaos Supreme Treasure? Have you ever seen one? Maybe just one Chaos Supreme Treasure can turn the tables. Why are you being so arrogant now? You haven't even taken half of the Divine Domains controlled by our Solar System. I advise you, while we haven't launched a counter-attack, those of you who received our Solar System Stars Citizenship Conversion Cards had better apply to convert your citizenship. There might still be a chance for you to survive. When we start our counter-attack, don't say we didn't give you a chance!"

It had to be said, the Solar System defenders' retorts were sharp, striking precisely at the Yongming Star System's vulnerabilities.

While the Yongming Star System forces appeared to hold a massive advantage, in reality, they were terrified.

Weren't they, in fact, accelerating their attacks precisely to prevent the super-genius on the opposing side from fully developing?

They didn't dare to slack off for even a second. The recent sound of the great path, heralding the Chaos Supreme Treasure, had truly shaken them to their core. A treasure of this Level—who knew what effects it could truly have? If they didn't seize the Divine Domains quickly and completely eject the Solar System from the competition, they feared they would soon be the ones under attack.

Hearing these retorts, the expressions of the Yongming Star System members naturally turned ugly, and their attacks grew even more vicious.

"Damn them, their mouths are tough! Let's see how your genius turns things around once all your Divine Domains are lost!"

As the professionals from the Yongming Star System unleashed their furious assault, the Solar System defenders were momentarily overwhelmed.

One legion's army shield even shattered. If those soldiers didn't retreat immediately, the next enemy attack would mean their certain deaths.

They had no choice but to retreat into an adjacent Divine Domain.

Their retreat freed up the enemy legion they had been holding back.

Previously, each Solar System legion had been retreating step by step, pitted against a single enemy legion. Now that one of the enemy legions was free, the subsequent course of the battle was all too clear.

In an instant, the army shield of every Solar System legion shook violently, on the verge of shattering.

Just as the members of several Solar System legions were desperately holding on, preparing to retreat into the neighboring Divine Domain only at the very last moment when their shields shattered...

Suddenly, a dazzling light flashed at the center of this Divine Domain. An overwhelmingly terrifying Divine Power Strength erupted from the central area!

"A hundred-man troop?"

"Did my perception ability malfunction? What level of Divine Power is this?"

"This Divine Power fluctuation... it feels like it's already far exceeded ten thousand points of Divine Power."

All members of the Extraterrestrial Coalition Army were stunned by this terrifying fluctuation.

The contrast in Divine Power was now stark. In a corner of this Divine Domain's battlefield, two Divine Power Troops, each wielding ten thousand points of Divine Power, were currently locked in a stalemate.

However, the Divine Power Strength erupting from the hundred-man troop now appearing in the central region far surpassed anything those two ten-thousand-point Divine Power Troops could compare to.

Even if the Divine Power of those two troops were combined, the resulting fluctuation wouldn't come close to matching this hundred-man squad that had appeared in the central area.

While the Extraterrestrial Coalition Army was stunned, the numerous troops from the Solar System all showed expressions of immense excitement.

They truly hadn't expected that the prominent figures from their ranks, who had suddenly departed, were involved in something of this magnitude.

When someone recognized the person leading the hundred-man squad, the professionals from the Solar System suddenly understood.

"Could this be the Chaos Supreme Treasure that Chen Mo obtained, the one The Heavenly Path's Hint mentioned before? I fear only a treasure of this caliber could achieve such an abnormal level of strength."

Once these words were spoken, many found them to be quite reasonable.

Meanwhile, the members of the Extraterrestrial Coalition Army, not far from them, were utterly aghast as they listened.
