Guilds focused on land-based transport are called Trade Guilds, offering players logistics skills and attack damage bonuses. Guilds specializing in adventure are called Adventurer Guilds, increasing the player's monster-killing drop rate and the chance to discover hidden treasures. The most mainstream one is the War Guild, which significantly improves the attributes of players' troops.

In fact, as long as a guild has enough money and enough people doing tasks, it can advance comprehensively in parallel development.

For example, during the open beta until the last day of closed beta, Star Guild's attribute was: Comprehensive Level 152 (War 72, Sea Commerce 30, Adventure 30, Trade 20).

The effect of a level 70 War Guild is that all player troop attributes increase by about 7%. Don't underestimate this 7% – it's like, when ten thousand people from both sides fight against each other, one side suddenly has 700 more soldiers.

Of course, the role of the guild is not just to give players a little buff; more importantly, many tasks with rich rewards can only be received by joining a guild, especially a large guild with high levels and prestige. Large projects need big trustworthy companies to undertake.

However, the benefits of a guild are so plentiful, but establishing one isn't that easy. In short, it requires constantly doing tasks to accumulate prestige, etc., which is very bothersome and painful.
