- Sharp Insight: Increases the chance of discovering treasures and successfully identifying counterfeits. The higher the Treasure Appraiser profession level, the stronger the skill effect. Reconnaissance Technique, Luck Skill, and this skill have mutual enhancing effects.

- System Prompt: You are currently level 34 and gained a beginner Treasure Appraiser profession bonus of 6 free attribute points.

- Vortex Crystal: Magic Power +10, Knowledge +10, Special Skill: Vortex Space Gate!

Vortex Space Gate! It's it! I also got a side profession! Da Fei laughed joyfully! One mouthful of cesspit water breached in—ah puh!

—System Prompt: Congratulations! Your Vice Hero Alicia successfully completed the navigator's test mission, officially promoted to Junior Navigator!

—System Prompt: You defeated Demigod Calubidis, achieving "Dancing with Gods," your life +50, all Vice Hero life +50, your Command Power +50, all Vice Hero Command Power +50, troop morale +1, troop life +1.

—System Prompt: You successfully defeated a demigod. Would you like to publicly announce this on the World Channel? Publicly announcing will gain 1000 world reputation points!

...

The Nether God wants to control it but unfortunately has no knowledge of water. The Sea God wants to control it but unfortunately the death energy is too heavy and doesn't suit him.

Just at this moment, Da Fei's Reconnaissance Skill sounded an alarm; a large amount of red dots appeared on the sea surface!

Da Fei's heart skipped a beat—a Sea Monster from the Netherworld? But as long as they're just small dots, brother isn't afraid! Da Fei immediately ordered the fleet to prepare for battle.

Da Fei's eyelid twitched, the Absolute Misfortune the Gambling God mentioned! Da Fei hurriedly checked his Luck attribute, Luck Value  $-\infty$ ! Negative infinity! What? This means no lucky charms could save me now?

The effects of misfortune were immediate. As another volley of Crossbow Arrows whistled down, all sorts of missed shots and halved damages, skewed damages scrolled across the screen, the Damage Values were pitiful to see! (Note: Skewed damage refers to "shooting askew," causing less than normal damage. Attacking underwater enemies or enemies with a Magic Shield usually results in skewed damage.)

Damn it! Da Fei is devastated!

Anyway, under the desperate cover of Radiant Wings, under the full-on spear attacks from the crew of Octopus, and through the crew's rapid repairs, the fleet finally, though painfully, dealt with the first wave of enemies they encountered in the Nether Sea.

——System Prompt: Warning! The bottom of the fleet's Whale Hunter has fractured, which is likely to cause the entire ship to break apart and sink! Immediate reduction of load and repair are necessary!
