We already have too many companions who have fallen and become one with the enemy. Can't we recruit the enemy, allowing former foes to replenish our forces? The Warrior has already managed to capture the enemy alive; we can't simply disregard the Warrior's efforts!"

Dor said solemnly, "If you just want to make the Demon serve us it's actually simple, just make a Demon Contract with it—"

Reilly smiled even sweeter, "However, warrior, these medicines are actually not free. Consider it an advance reward from me. If you have any left, I can exchange them for reputation in Divine Punishment City."

I'm flabbergasted; we're on the brink of war here, can we not talk about money? I know one bottle of this crap goes for 200 essences, and for the price of 3 bottles, I could get an Angel, so no way I'm buying. Anyway, I'm gladly taking it!

— Divine Power Staff: Divine Artifact, A rented item, quest item (Bound equip can't be traded or dropped), Attack +30, Magic Power +30, can use the Divine Arts "Divine Suppression" 3 times. The effect is better when used by a Knight or Priest hero profession.

Chapter 722: Elite Intelligence Angel Promotion to Boss

Now, the Blood Eagle flapped its wings toward the volcano. The good news Da Fei brought invigorated the whole team, especially Billbo, who was so excited he jumped for joy and immediately threw himself into the skinning business with even more enthusiasm.

Perhaps the howling of the trapped Wolf King had played an effective role in intimidating the creatures around the mountainous area. During the time Da Fei's Blood Eagle was shuttling back and forth to Divine Punishment City, no monsters appeared nearby.

No monsters were exactly a good thing, allowing us to take advantage of this rare peaceful period. Elena was the first to restore her mana and resurrected seven Volcano Demon Wolves that had fallen in battle. As expected, the infernal environment not only did not weaken the Dark Magic at all but even somewhat strengthened it. Each Demon Wolf had at least half of its Life Value upon resurrection, while normally resurrected troops would be without any health.

Generally speaking, any hero could learn the four major magic types: Light, Dark, Destruction, and Arcane. However, due to racial differences, the effects of magic varied. Human heroes could normally learn all magic types, but it was not recommended to learn both Light and Dark Magic simultaneously, as mutual interference would weaken the effects of one type of magic.

Undead had a high racial bonus when learning Dark Magic, and Demons had a high racial bonus for Destruction Magic, but learning Arcane Magic resulted in a decline in effects. As for learning Light Magic, it was almost a waste of Skill Points, consuming a lot of mana, with short durations, not to mention Dark Creatures generally would not benefit from Light Magic enhancements.

As for Beastmen, not much needed to be said—they were magical idiots! What they needed to learn were their race's unique skills like "Anti-Light Magic" and "Anti-Dark Magic." Of course, the magic of Beastman Shamans was not called Magic; it was akin to the Natural Magic of Druids.

Elves, among all races, were exceptionally adaptable to magic. Except for the Dark Magic, which was like wasting Skill Points, they could handle other types of magic. The Druid profession, even more so, had its unique Druid Technique. And the Dark Elf, after all, was still an Elf, slightly better at adapting to Dark Magic but not on par with Undead and Demon levels.

In short, Dark Elves learning Dark Magic were most useful only for resurrection. They were genuinely not good at using large-scale Dark Magic spells that debilitated enemy troops' attack and defense. If the enemy's Magic Resistance was a bit higher, the spell might fail, wasting both opportunities and mana. It was better to hit the enemy with a direct magic blast.

And what Da Fei needed in this battle was a master of Dark Magic to control the field. Otherwise, under the control of God-level Destruction Techniques combined with the full set of Black Magic slowing effects, the scene would have been extremely exciting! Ultimately, it was because Deirdre did not come out.

For a moment, Da Fei couldn't help but sigh with melancholy nostalgia. More distressing was that, during this time, Selvia and the Elite Wisdom Angel managed to only restore four of the Forest Goddess troops. Half of the units that died in battle had not yet been revived, progress was excruciatingly slow, and a day of game time was about to pass. The remaining units might not last until resurrection.

In summary, the only thing to do now was to quickly transport the potions back to enhance their spell-casting effects.

Of course, another major task loomed ahead. After being tormented by the eleven Holy Vines, dealing "-10" damage per vine per second and additionally draining life, blue mana, and stamina, the Wolf King's howls were much weaker than before. It was about time to recruit it. However, the Divine Power Staff worked best when used by a Knight or Priest, but I was a newbie, neither a Knight nor a Priest!

So, it could only be given to Selvia. The Nun profession was an even more reclusive and specialized hidden Hero profession than the Priest; she was the most suitable candidate. As for the lost Life, well, just consume the Life Book. I would buy it from suppliers across the server.

Da Fei was suddenly overjoyed, two units revived this time! A 30% increase meant reviving 1.3 units, right? Of course, there's no such thing as 1.3 units; it meant the potion just pushed her past the threshold! Yes, this was the desired effect!

Then, the system prompts sounded again:

—System Prompt: Your Power Angel Army used the skill Resurrection Technique, successfully reviving 1 Forest Goddess unit.

—System Prompt: Your Power Angel Army... successfully revived 1 Forest Goddess unit.

Da Fei laughed heartily! Great! Finally, the previously idle Power Angel and Power Angel Army did not disappoint and managed to revive successfully. In the end, they were just a tiny bit short of reviving before. Now it's better; there's complete hope to revive all the units before the day ends!

Now, the Elite Intelligence Angel fully restored mana to continue resurrecting. No need to say, her resurrection ability equaled Selvia's, definitely reviving two.

With a flash of resurrection gold, it happened just so!

—System Prompt: Your Elite Intelligence Angel Army used the skill Resurrection Technique, successfully reviving 2 Forest Goddess units.

And just then, a white light descended upon the Elite Intelligence Angel!

—System Prompt: Congratulations! Your Elite Intelligence Angel Army grew during the battle, successfully advancing to Leader-level Intelligence Angel!

Da Fei was so shocked his jaw dropped to the floor, the Intelligence Angel advanced! That's right, the white light just now was identical to the one when Didi, Lili, and the Blood Eagle advanced years ago! That means Selvia gained God-level information through resurrection, while the Intelligence Angel gained advancement experience?

So that's it! I could cultivate a BOSS all along; why bother trying so hard to recruit some troublesome BOSS! Haha, haha!

Chapter 723: Comprehending God-level Light Magic

— Intelligence Angel Elifel: Large-sized Light Spirit Leader-level creature, Attack 45, Defense 65, Damage 60-75, Life Value 2900, Attack Speed 13, Mana 2000, Command Value 200, Space Item Bar 1, Special Skill: Flying Creature, Holy Body, Resurrection, Strong Healing Skill, Strong Meditation Skill.

— Strong Healing Skill: Consumes 100 Mana to restore up to 25% Life Value for a unit's tactical position. The more troops, the less effective the recovery.

— Strong Meditation Skill: Consumes 100 Mana to increase the mana recovery speed of a unit's tactical position by up to 300%. The more troops, the less effective the recovery.

Elifel? It's already named right from the start? The attack and defense damage attributes didn't increase much, and the life value only increased by about a thousand, still not as much as the Unicorn Boss's 5000 health. It's not suitable for charge and battle, but the 2000 Mana is indeed astonishing. Generally, a Mage Hero player would need 200 knowledge points to reach 2000 mana without achieving accomplishments or completing tasks, which is clearly impossible.

That's right, the key is that the skills have been upgraded. Previously, both Strong Healing and Strong Meditation have all upgraded to "Great"! This means she alone could be as effective as a Healing Priest Hero!

And as a grown-up Boss, she, like the Blood Eagle, also has a Space Item Bar, albeit only one. In any case, it's just when my army urgently needs to recruit the Demon Wolf King that the upgrade to Boss of Intelligence Angel further widened the military strength gap between the two sides, increasing the chance of a successful recruit!

Elifel was surprised and said, "The duty of a Lower-level Angel Soldier is to fight for the warriors, requiring neither a name nor speech, but once the abilities of Angel Soldiers improve, they can undertake other jobs for the warriors and naturally need to display their names."

Da Fei chuckled in amusement. It seems she misunderstood and answered a different question. But ultimately, it was my question that was pointless.

Da Fei continued to ask, "What other kinds of tasks are you capable of, then?"

Elifel replied, "I am proficient in the statutes of Heaven and some related affairs. If you intend to develop toward Heaven, I can remind you of the precautions at any time."

Ah, Heaven and such are really too distant now. But it's good; it's like having an Angel Honey, haha, I like it!

So Da Fei introduced Anlicia, Selvia, Elena, and other beauties to her one by one. Of course, it's actually unnecessary in the game, but adding another member to the harmonious harem feeling is the greatest enjoyment of being a player.

Da Fei's heart tightened, was it not working? Even after using divine techniques, and with it being beaten down like this, it still couldn't be recruited?

Alina frowned and said, "Maybe its soul was shocked and it's not conscious?"

Da Fei nodded, "That makes sense, then let's wait and everyone take the opportunity to recover stamina!"

Time passed second by second. The Demon Wolf still lay on the Corpse Mountain, motionless, with no system prompt of death nor any star-spinning icons like when the Earth Dragon was stunned. Da Fei was completely at a loss. What was going on? Could it be it was dumbstruck by Divine Suppression?

Da Fei then approached Selvia and asked, "Um, Elifel, can you hear me? What exactly is going on?"

——System Prompt: The Hell Volcano Demon Wolf King fears your might and wants to surrender and join your team, do you accept?

——System Prompt: Congratulations! Your Vice Hero Selvia successfully recruited the Leader-level creature "Hell Volcano Demon Wolf King" and comprehended Master-level Leadership Skill!

Surrender? Surrendering at this time? At this moment, Da Fei was dumbfounded! What a cunning BOSS, fighting if able, withstanding if unable to fight, running if unable to withstand, surrendering if unable to run! Why are you so overpowered? Well, in light of you allowing Selvia to double celebrate and successfully advance to Grandmaster, I won't kill you, haha, wa hahaha!

——System Prompt: You accepted the surrender of the Hell Volcano Demon Wolf King, the Hell Demon Wolf King has joined your team!

——System Prompt: Battle ended! You defeated the Hell Volcano Demon Wolf King, you gained Experience +2.03 million!

——System Prompt: Congratulations! Your Vice Hero Alina leveled up to level 35...

——System Prompt: Congratulations! Your Vice Hero Alicia leveled up to level 41...

The battle ended, and the whole team was roaring with cheers.

Da Fei couldn't wait to start checking out the attributes of this Demon Wolf King, who had exhausted him so much and battled with him for so long before finally being successfully recruited:

——Hell Volcano Demon Wolf King: Giant Leader-level Demon Creature, Attack 100, Defense 85, Damage 100-135, Life 15500, Attack Speed 21, Magic Resistance 90%, Command Value 2000 (red text warning), Mana 350, Stamina 600, Special Skill: Flying Creature, Horror Howl, Quick Recovery, Rapid Bite, Crushing Attack, Sensitive Hearing, Sensitive Smell.
