This is a stellar space supreme treasure, moreover it's the only transmission type supreme treasure in the entire stellar space, if acknowledged by it, regardless of the cultivation level, it can allow one to be recognized as its master.

In comparison, what difficulty to claim other stellar space supreme treasures? No matter how strong the Sun Blaze, so many Sun Blaze in the stellar space, yet how many control stellar space supreme treasures?

Just a pity that after the battle back then, the Nine Provinces vanished, and the Dao Tree legacy went missing with it.
