"To be precise, the strategy I would adopt would be more than 90% similar to Tian Fan's, and I would even tend to lay off all employees at the very beginning, rather than waiting until after the natural disaster."

Fu Chen reminded, "But these decisions ultimately need the president to make the final call."

Wang Yongxin nodded, "Yes, this is the main difference between me and Tian Fan.

"At the beginning of the game, I would do everything possible to compete for the president position, rather than possibly being just an executive.

"I cannot accept situations where my decisions are not executed."

Everyone fell into silence. As Wang Yongxin said, if he and Tian Fan entered this game together as opponents, one of them would inevitably die.

Because to win this game, the most crucial point was ending the economic winter, which required achieving three specific conditions:

"Although this game has company management as its theme, the actual company management gameplay is just a red herring.

"It's a judgment game, targeting two types of people

"The first type is people like Xu Tong, Tian Fan, and Brother Wang, who exploit employees, bully the weak, and have no compassion for the vulnerable."

She looked at Wang Yongxin and Xu Tong, "I might be speaking rather directly, please don't take offense."

"If you have social responsibility but no management ability, stubbornly refusing to lay off employees and unable to balance income and expenditure, the company will eventually go bankrupt."

"Only by having both management ability and social responsibility can you truly end the economic winter and receive excess returns in the final three rounds."

"In all other situations, the sinners being judged may face immediate death punishment."

Cao Haichuan sighed silently, "So, you two had actually completed the judgment tasks."

"But Aunt Su, even after confirming the game was already won, still chose to enter the cold storage."

"I wonder if this possibility was within the God's Imitator's initial expectations."
