Chapter 129: Career Choices

"But with an 11:0 disparity, I think it's necessary to recruit a truly poor person, even if they may not be useful in many games, they can optimize our community's knowledge structure."

Cao Haichuan said: "I agree with this perspective. Also, I want to remind everyone of another matter:

"From this point on, we must pay special attention to the 'loyalty' issue when recruiting new members.

"Our community will not proactively kick out any player, nor will we proactively poach any player.

"However, people in our community might be poached by other communities.

"The 11 of us started in Community 17, even if our ideals differ, our familiarity and mutual trust are better compared to strangers from other communities.

"But for a new member, that's not necessarily the case.

"To a new member, Community 17 is an unfamiliar environment, and so are other communities, so where they stay makes no difference.

"And if a member does get poached by another community, it's not just losing one person.

"The poaching operation can only occur within the game.

"Once a person decides to betray, they are likely to collaborate with the poaching community to harm us in the game, both as a gesture of loyalty to the poaching community and maximizing their own benefits.

"Under such circumstances, other players in the game might suffer fatal losses."
