### Chapter 201: True Intentions

Cai Zhiyuan had obviously already considered this question.

"First, let's look at the specific rules for poaching.

"From the previous 'Conglomerate Nation' situation, our community currently has 11 people with one vacancy, so we can directly poach specific players without needing to kick anyone out.

"Poaching requires simultaneously meeting two conditions:
