Chapter 225: The Final Plan

The third round of Guess the Number began.

"I'll keep 20 for myself, and the last 20 will be distributed to the others in our small group.

"This is the true 'optimal distribution plan.'

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With most players unaware of the inside story, the final result of 'Guess the Number' was already determined.

'Rabbit' and 'Sheep' together came to the two small groups of 'Owl' and 'Sika Deer' to distribute Contract Vouchers.

'Rabbit' Han Mengying wanted to ensure every voucher was distributed according to her plan.

What they distributed openly was naturally 'Sheep's' Contract Vouchers, 35 to each small group, all evenly divided among each player.

Those players with more visa time could exchange a total of 60,000 chips over 3 hours.

At the same time, through the method of cooperating to collect basic subsistence at the battle platform, they could also obtain some additional chips.

Players who didn't have enough chips used the 'Sheep's' Contract Vouchers they had just received to exchange chips with players inside the small group at the battle platform. Each Contract Voucher was recognized as having a value of at least 10,000 chips.
