### Chapter 284: Recruiting and Core Sign-ups

The next morning.

The players gathered in the hall again for a meeting.

Clearly, after Li Renshu chatted with Lin Sizhi last night, she had also communicated with other people who should be informed, so at this moment she directly presented the proposal.

"Today's meeting is because there's still a relatively important issue that needs to be resolved: recruiting new members.

"During this time, I've also privately exchanged views with some players, and I've tried to consider things as comprehensively as possible, especially Lawyer Lin's viewpoint.

"So I'll just give the result directly:

"Currently there are two recruitment methods. One is the traditional method, which is screening from new players through community rules. The other is the recruiting method.

"Both methods have their respective problems. The former has a cooldown time, while the latter can't ensure we'll happen to encounter people worth recruiting every time we enter a game.

"And our primary goal is to maintain the community at full capacity as much as possible at all times.

"So we should try to utilize both recruitment methods as much as possible. This time we'll directly adopt the traditional method to recruit. If the traditional method is on cooldown, then we'll recruit people from games.

"There are two specific issues.

"First is what profession we should recruit.

"Currently, the calls for 'police' and 'military' are relatively high.

"Second is the issue of recruiting authority.

"Recruiting requires entering the corresponding game, but Lawyer Lin can't possibly enter every game. That burden would be too heavy. Moreover, many games directionally screen for the weak and don't have voluntary participation slots, like 'Shelter Game'.

"So Lawyer Lin believes we should reselect a team-leading core for games, ensuring the game cores within the community still maintain 3 people.

"And have each game core obtain the power to recruit.

"So today we're mainly voting on these two matters.

"First is determining the new player's profession.

"Second is determining the preliminary screening list for game cores.

"My thinking is that players who want to become game cores should voluntarily sign up first. We'll comprehensively consider performance over the 'next three games' and determine the new game core through voting from among these signed-up players.

"What does everyone think?"

Everyone looked at each other, then nodded one after another, "That works."

No one raised objections.

Li Renshu continued, "Alright, then let's vote on the first item first, whether it should be 'military' or 'police'.

"As for the other two factors, gender and age, I don't think there are other choices. It can only be 'young male'.

"As for whether it's 'military' or 'police', I think the difference isn't large.

"If it's a criminal investigator like Officer Cao with rich case-solving experience and strong problem-solving ability in games, that would naturally be the best situation, but I think this possibility is very low.

"Should we first have a simple show of hands vote, or vote directly?"

Cai Zhiyuan said, "Let's do an anonymous vote within the community directly. If we show hands, some people might be embarrassed to speak their true inner thoughts."

Li Renshu nodded. She went to the Community Management Office to submit the proposal. Soon, the corresponding information appeared on the large screen.

[Proposal 1: New recruit candidate, young male military personnel.]

[In favor: 6 votes]

[Against: 5 votes]

[New recruit candidate, young male police officer vote did not pass.]

[New recruit candidate, young male military personnel vote passed. The community will screen within a certain range according to this requirement and bring in a new player relatively meeting the result.]

But according to the rules within the community, as long as more than half the players agreed, the proposal could pass, so in a situation where there were only 11 people in the community, 6 votes were already sufficient.

From a voting principles perspective, this vote couldn't be considered successful.

It would be best to further distinguish the numbers between the two options as much as possible through a second vote or adjusting voting details.
