Chapter 62: Three Proposals

Obviously, for someone like Wang Yongxin who contributed more money, he would definitely prefer to get more back.

But the problem was that the visa time in the Community Protection Fund pool was accumulated from many contributions, making it very difficult to distinguish exactly how much each person had contributed.

In this situation, a proportional return plan would be very troublesome, so it was better to just divide equally.

Li Renshu nodded, "Good, then this clause is passed?"

"If we purchase medical supplies individually, it would not only cause waste, but there might also be situations where unconscious players cannot make purchases.

"If we want to use the Community Protection Fund, since it involves public funds, to prevent misuse, in principle we would need to submit proposals and go through voting procedures for safety.

"But this could very likely delay treatment for the injured.

"If we stockpile medical supplies in advance, it could easily cause unnecessary waste. It's better to buy as needed.

"All these problems can be solved by establishing a medical supplies manager.

"Everyone might worry that this person would line their own pockets or deliberately empty the Community Protection Fund.

"I've made two restrictions for this: first, their authority is limited to purchasing medical supplies from vending machines, and when cumulative spending reaches 10,000 minutes of visa time, they must submit details for full review before another 10,000-minute quota can be opened; second, as long as voting reaches seven votes, they can be dismissed and replaced at any time."

Everyone looked at each other silently, but still no one objected.

Jiang He smiled somewhat helplessly, "Renshu, you've thought this through so comprehensively, anticipating everything we did and didn't think of and writing it all into the proposal.

"What else is there to say? I think there's absolutely no problem."

"Of course, I'm not saying that older people necessarily have bad character.

"It's just that relatively speaking, among doctors who have climbed to high positions and have the ability to engage in these underhanded activities, older ones are obviously the majority; while young doctors for the most part haven't been exposed to these dark sides yet and still have relatively noble ideals.

"So I believe a young surgeon would be a better choice.

"As for whether it should be male or female, I think we don't need too much discussion. Gender topics ultimately just become people talking past each other. We might as well follow the established principle: maintain a strict 6:6 male-female ratio in the community, which is fairest.

"Next time if there's a female reduction in personnel, we would also only recruit females.

"Additionally, I think recruitment choices should be strictly limited to three keywords. The broadcast actually already gave us hints: age, gender, profession. If we wishfully adopt other keywords, they probably won't be included in the screening criteria.

"We could certainly propose requirements like 'a 35-year-old male military surgeon with excellent culinary skills, rich medical knowledge, and extremely high intelligence,' but the rules also clearly state that this recruitment is screening, not wish-making.
