Tao Qian swallowed the bait, thus interrupting his cultivation.


The intense sensation of information reassured him that he could indeed acquire the Bo Dragon Pearl Fragment without any price to pay.


The information that he had not had time to examine in the Immortal Realm now reappeared before him.


[Record: Bo Dragon Pearl Fragment.]

[Record Type: Alien.]

At the new moon, it lies facing west, lifting its head to bellow until the rooster crows, startling tigers and leopards, clearing several hundred miles around. This fragment represents one percent of its Dragon Pearl. Any life that consumes it will obtain the Bo Dragon Bloodline, and should mortals ingest it, they can instantly enter the Energy-Introducing Realm and obtain the Bloodline Techniques and racial Divine Skills.]




What made Tao Qian somewhat helpless was that he now lived in a bustling area.

"If one introduces low-grade Qi filled with impurities, upon success, one might at best gain some mediocre abilities like tough skin, horns growing on the head, night vision, a third hand, or a body odor that stinks to high heaven." "If one introduces top-grade, pure Source Qi, like I have now, one might be powerful enough to dominate dozens or hundreds of inferior Energy-Introducing Cultivators."
