"Two traits indeed."

The effect at Level 1 is a ten percent reduction in the rate of aging.

However, a martial artist's constitution is vastly different from that of an ordinary person.

An average person who doesn't exercise or maintain their health might go from a vigorous youth to a middle-aged person in ten years.

For one who exercises daily and maintains their health, this process might take fifteen to twenty years.

For a martial artist, this process could last thirty to forty years. On that basis, a further ten percent reduction could extend this period to over forty years.

That's just the effect at Level 1. At the Perfection Realm, the effect at Level 5 can slow the aging rate by nearly forty percent!

Martial artists at the same level would have graying hair while practitioners of the Longevity Technique would still have jet-black hair or only a few wrinkles.

As the saying goes, "Flowers may bloom again, but a person never regains youth." This kind of effect is irresistible.

To further slow down the aging process, one would need to acquire the subsequent volumes of the Longevity Technique.

Why were Beast Tides terrifying? It's because of the endless Fierce Beasts. No matter how strong a martial artist, once their True Qi was exhausted, they'd have to rely on physical strength, and if that too was exhausted, they could only wait for death.

This trait, however, would allow a cultivator's True Qi to naturally recover at twice the previous speed. The more depleted the True Qi, the faster the recovery speed, up to four times the previous.

If cultivated to perfection, the normal recovery speed would be four times the previous, and in extreme cases, it could be ten times!

What does this mean?

Chen Fan calculated that in a meditative state, it took three hours to fully recover his True Qi.

If he didn't meditate but let it recover naturally, it would take about twelve hours.
