### Chapter 337: The World's Strongest Magical Beast

Typhon, also known as Typhoeus, is a Titan giant in Greek mythology, the son of Gaia, Mother Earth.

He was born in a cave in the region of Cilicia, and from birth possessed a terrifying appearance and power—a monster even Zeus, King of the Gods, feared.

Together with his wife Echidna, Typhon gave birth to many terrifying monsters, such as the hundred-headed dragon Ladon, the nine-headed Hydra, the three-headed hound of the underworld Cerberus, the two-headed dog Orthrus, the giant lion Nemean Lion, the chimera Chimera, the sphinx Sphinx, and the sea monster Scylla, among others.
