As Lu Chen's voice spread, everyone quickly headed outside the cave.


Linglong and Du Hui were puzzled, but immediately followed.


They had long known the effects of the Spirit Vein Cage Immortal Talisman, but this was the first time they witnessed such a scene upon its activation.


