Breeder is the main theme throughout this book. It is also known as 'péiyù jiā*' in Chinese, but I prefer the word 'Breeder' because it encompasses a broader and deeper concept. In my worldview, items like Potion, Antidote, Heal Powder, Iron Vitamin, and even Rare Candy in games are all creations of a Breeder. [*It's just another word for breeder used in chinese.]

Similarly, the Joy Family can be considered a Breeder family. They hold an unrivaled monopoly on the breeding knowledge of Pokémon healthcare and nurturing, with no one able to surpass their expertise. In the Emerald Version Game, there is also a Stats Judge known as the Top Pokémon Breeder at the Battle Frontier. If placed in the real world, Individual Values can be considered as innate talent or potential, and I believe it would be a fitting description. Of course, the efforts put in after birth are equally important. Items like Silver Powder, Spell Tag, and Repel to prevent encountering Pokémon—there are so many examples that can be associated with the magical profession of a Breeder. I aim to present a worldview that revolves around the identity of a

Breeder, which will assist Terrance greatly on his journey to becoming an excellent Coordinator or Trainer!
