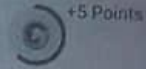
Although initially it wasn't known which decade will have all the five elements, it was becoming clear now.

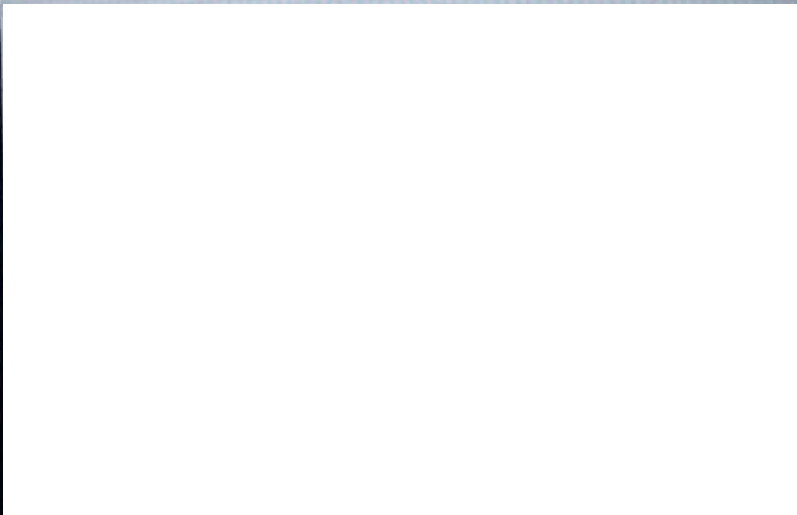
