Chapter 161: Fake Pill

Even Meng Zhang, who was immersed in closed-door cultivation, was alarmed by a series of major events happening outside. He couldn't understand how the news about Twin Success Valley secretly cultivating Gold Core Daoist Masters, which should have been the highest secret of the valley, had leaked and become widely known.

In the past, there were faint rumors about this matter spreading, and even the spies of the Flying Swan Sect had gathered some clues. Meng Zhang had also obtained some information from Li Nu, a spy of the Flying Swan Sect.

However, the news that was originally circulating within a small circle suddenly spread on a large scale.

The Flying Swan Sect was not in a hurry to take action against Twin Success Valley; instead, they planned to observe and witness Twin Success Valley's success or failure. If Twin Success Valley cultivators really started forming the core, Flying Swan Sect would naturally intervene to stop it.

After this news spread, not only was Twin Success Valley in a difficult situation, but even the Flying Swan Sect could no longer remain silent.

As the ruler of the Endless Sea of Sand, although it was never explicitly stated, all forces knew that the Flying Swan Sect would never allow other forces to cultivate Gold Core Daoist Masters.

Now that Twin Success Valley had revealed signs of doing so, if the Flying Swan Sect did nothing, it would be seen as condoning such behavior and would damage its own prestige.

The recent actions of the Flying Swan Sect, though directed at Twin Success Valley, also affected Taiyi Sect, which was a vassal force of Twin Success Valley.

The fall of Singing Sand City had a significant impact on Taiyi Sect. It not only lost the meager income from the grocery store but also lost a channel for procuring resources.

Originally, the secretly mined scarlet copper ore was sold to the Earthfire Sect. However, in the current situation, Earthfire Sect had to temporarily suspend its trade with Taiyi Sect due to the orders from the Flying Swan Sect.

Taiyi Sect, being a vassal force of Twin Success Valley, was also blocked. Its disciples could not pass through the blockade lines of the major forces to go to Singing Sand City and Firewell Market.

The Flying Swan Sect thought it through carefully and was worried that Twin Success Valley might use the name of its vassal force to conduct external resource trading. Therefore, all caravans of Twin Success Valley's vassal forces were not allowed to pass through the blockade lines.

Taiyi Sect had stable trade with Lao Bulu, but due to the orders of the Flying Swan Sect, Lao Bulu temporarily stopped buying the white hidden earth ore mined by Taiyi Sect.

The situation was not too bad as Taiyi Sect already had a certain degree of self-sufficiency. The annual harvest of spirit grain could barely meet the needs of its disciples. The alchemical trade with Shi Weiming had only changed location and was not greatly affected.

Although Taiyi Sect lost the income from selling scarlet copper ore, Twin Success Valley had been purchasing white hidden earth ore at market price. After Lao Bulu stopped buying, Twin Success Valley continued purchasing all the white hidden earth ore and urged Taiyi Sect to invest more manpower to increase the mining volume.

As long as Taiyi Sect could maintain its current state, Meng Zhang wasn't too worried. What he needed to do now was to build the Foundation as soon as possible. With the strength of the Foundation Building stage, he would have a stronger ability to cope with the upcoming major changes.

On this day, in the main hall of Twin Success Valley, almost all the elders were gathered for an elder assembly to decide the next steps for the sect.

While False Core cultivators were inferior to genuine Gold Core cultivators in both strength and lifespan, they had an overwhelming advantage over Foundation Building completion cultivators.

For years, Twin Success Valley had been publicly disclosing that the once renowned disciple, Xiao Fengyan, had died during meditation due to his depleted lifespan. In reality, Xiao Fengyan was hiding within the sect and only revealed himself during crucial moments. Only the Foundation Building stage elders within the sect were aware of Xiao Fengyan's existence.

Now, with Twin Success Valley convening an elder assembly that concerned the life and death of the sect, Xiao Fengyan naturally wouldn't be absent.

Chapter 162: Determination

Chapter 164: Drives out the Demon Air/Qi
