## Chapter 199

After completing the introductory manual, Meng Zhang did not leave the mountain gate but stayed to cultivate. In his spare time, he also guided Niu Dawei's cultivation. Although Meng Zhang had not practiced "Wind and Thunder True Cultivation" himself, and no one else in the sect practiced this technique, as a Foundation Building cultivator, he had a keen insight and was able to apply his knowledge to help Niu Dawei progress quickly. Meng Zhang carefully studied the various intricacies of "Wind and Thunder True Cultivation" and with his excellent aptitude and guidance, Niu Dawei's cultivation base improved rapidly.

In addition, the treasure obtained from Twin Success Valley's Dan Yihu, which was half of the secret library, was already transported back to Taiyi Sect by Deep Earth God. Most of the cultivation resources and spirit stones were sent to the sect's treasury. After Deep Earth Spirit General organized the books and jade slips, they were sent to the Hidden Scripture Pavilion. The current Hidden Scripture Pavilion of Taiyi Sect had a considerable collection of books and was no longer a small study room but a three-story building with its own area and protection restrictions

outside, guarded by disciples. Each room in the building had talismans inscribed to prevent fire and insect damage.

The Hidden Scripture Pavilion was not just an empty shell, it contained a large number of books, including precious classics. Apart from the first floor, which was open to the sect's disciples for free, the books on the other two floors required the consumption of sect contribution points to borrow. #### **Chapter 200: Later Generation**

Qiaoshou Sect and Golden Blade Sect have been allied for many years, maintaining a close relationship. The two sects have cooperated seamlessly, taking advantage of the vacuum left by the demise of Twin Success Valley and reaping the most fruitful rewards. Even Taiyi Sect, led by Meng Zhang, has had to step back in the face of the united front formed by the two sects.

However, any alliance must be built on a foundation of relative equality between the parties involved. In the Cultivation World, achieving equal status requires a reasonable balance of power.
