The Fire Cloud Sect still has two Gold Core mid-stage cultivators in name, but they are completely useless in the upcoming major battle in the Endless Sea of Sand.

Meng Zhang. If it weren't for Jin LiDaoist Master revealing the truth today, Meng Zhang would still be worried about Daoist Master Firecloud and Daoist Master Blueflame.

If they provoked him, he could switch to the side of the Fire Cloud Sect and seek the protection of True Monarch Profound Wind. The balance of power would immediately reverse, and the situation would quickly deteriorate.

Fei Shi Daoist Master didn't know Meng Zhang well enough and could only speculate with the worst intentions.

The three Gold Core Daoist Masters from Fire Cloud Sect had a strong desire to win, but being weaker than their opponents, they were already giving their all just to maintain a stalemate. Whenever they made a move to overpower the Flying Swan Sect, Meng Zhang and Qi NanfeiDaoist Master would also act in unison to maintain the balance of the battle. When they became exhausted

and started to recover their strength, Meng Zhang and Qi NanfeiDaoist Master would ease their efforts, pretending to be unable to keep up.

Due to the hidden intentions of Meng Zhang and Qi NanfeiDaoist Master, the aerial battle reached a stalemate. On the ground, the cultivator armies of Flying Swan Sect and Taiyi Sect joined forces to resist the cultivator army of Fire Cloud Sect.

These people were truly cunning, understanding well the way of survival for the weak. The Flying Swan Sect and Taiyi Sect, being righteous sects, generally refrained from killing prisoners. Moreover, these cultivators had surrendered willingly in public, showing sincere intentions.

Seeing the Fire Cloud Sect cultivators successfully retreat under their noses, the Flying Swan Sect's cultivators were filled with suppressed anger. They wanted to vent on these prisoners, but they had to consider the presence of Taiyi Sect and Northern Desert Qi Family's cultivators.
