Chapter 523: Attacks the mountain

With the care of the Gold Core Daoist Master, the safety of the cannon fodder cultivators is somewhat guaranteed. Every time the great formation launches an attack and begins to counter, the Gold Core Daoist Master is able to react promptly and block the counterattack of the great formation. Seeing their own Gold Core Daoist Master being so powerful, the morale of the cannon fodder cultivators is boosted, and they start to attack more fiercely.

The Flying Swan Sect has ruled the Endless Sea of Sand for hundreds of years and has extensive experience in commanding cannon fodder cultivators. In fact, many of the participating cultivators have previous experience fighting under the banner of the Flying Swan Sect. When the Flying Swan Sect commands these cannon fodder cultivators, they do not simply suppress them or let them die in vain. All the cannon fodder cultivators take turns to go into battle, and after each team of cultivators completes their attack mission, they are given a chance to rest.

The efficiency of the cannon fodder cultivators' attacks has greatly improved, and they are starting to exert more and more pressure on the great formation. The Fire Cloud Sect cultivators naturally cannot just stand by and do nothing. They have many means at their disposal, taking advantage of their position behind the great formation.

When it was Qi Nanfei Daoist Master's turn to take care of these cannon fodder cultivators, Daoist Master Scarlet Flame personally controlled the Blazing Flames Overturning Earth Great Formation and unleashed multiple changes. Not only did it cause a large number of casualties among the cannon fodder cultivators, but even Qi Nanfei Daoist Master himself was left embarrassed and almost injured. Fortunately, Daoist Master Fei Shi and the others reacted in time and launched a counterattack on the great formation, helping Qi Nanfei Daoist Master out of the predicament.

Qi Nanfei Daoist Master, who had been humiliated, became furious. As for those cannon fodder cultivators, they saw that under the care of the Gold Core Daoist Master, they suffered heavy casualties, and their morale immediately collapsed. In the face of life and death, they abandoned their loved ones and fellow disciples and only cared about saving themselves. Wu Mingwei took the initiative to fly over and personally executed a group of people who were the first to flee, which deterred the others.

Then the supervising cultivators from the Flying Swan Sect made efforts to reorganize these cannon fodder cultivators. However, after this incident, it was no longer possible to continue the attack that day, and time was wasted in vain. After a night of rest, the Flying Swan Sect, relying on its rich experience in commanding subordinates, barely managed to control the teams of cannon fodder cultivators. Early the next morning, they continued to drive them into battle.

In the following time, the four Gold Core Daoist Masters continued to attack the mountain-guarding great formation, and the cannon fodder cultivators kept rushing forward desperately. The damage to the mountain-guarding great formation was limited, and the Fire Cloud Sect cultivators remained unharmed. It was the cannon fodder cultivators recruited by the Flying Swan Sect who suffered heavy losses, and even the supervising cultivators suffered significant casualties.

Teams of cultivators dispatched by the Flying Swan Sect were still running around in the Endless Sea of Sand, but it was becoming increasingly difficult to recruit cultivators for battle. The speed of

replenishing the cannon fodder cultivators was far behind the speed of their losses, and it was almost impossible to continue.

Having suffered such great losses, the Taiyi Sect and the Northern Desert Qi Family naturally could not just stand by. It was time for the Taiyi Sect to take action. Although Meng Zhang felt a little reluctant, faced with the current dire situation, he reluctantly ordered the Taiyi Sect to join the battle.

The approach of the Taiyi Sect was similar to that of the Flying Swan Sect, with Taiyi Sect cultivators driving the cannon fodder cultivators into battle. Not only were the newly joined cultivation forces of the Taiyi Sect recruited, but even the members of the Hanhai Alliance and the loose cultivators hired from the Jiuqu League were not spared.

Due to his young age and some remnants of his mindset from before crossing over, Meng Zhang still retained a bit of kindness in his heart. Of course, in the eyes of those decisive cultivators, this was considered weakness. The members of the Hanhai Alliance even regarded him as hypocritical and pretentious. Regardless of what others thought, Meng Zhang tried to act according to his own conscience and make his intentions clear.

Before the war broke out, he spent a lot of money to purchase a large number of mechanical puppets from the Clever Machine Sect. He shamelessly requested Gu Yue Huaidie to intervene and asked the Clever Machine Sect to sell some of their unreleased Mechanical Creations to the Taiyi Sect. The Taiyi Sect had frequent dealings with the Clever Machine Sect over the years and was a rare major customer.

The Taiyi Sect needed the Clever Machine Sect's Mechanical Creations, and the Clever Machine Sect needed various spiritual materials provided by the Taiyi Sect, especially some unique mineral resources from the Endless Sea of Sand. Faced with the strong request from the Taiyi Sect and the face of the Gu Yue Family, the Clever Machine Sect sold some rare Mechanical Creations to the Taiyi Sect and specifically instructed them that these items could only be used internally and must not be leaked.

Before the cannon fodder cultivators launched their attack, the Taiyi Sect cultivators released countless mechanical puppets. In addition to a large number of First Rank puppets, there were also many Second Rank puppets. With the cover of these puppets, the cannon fodder cultivators began to launch attacks on the mountain-guarding great formation.

Meng Zhang spent a huge amount of spirit stones this time, almost emptying the Clever Machine Sect's inventory. Stimulated by the high price of spirit stones, the Clever Machine Sect is now working overtime to produce various Mechanical Creations for the Taiyi Sect.

The cannon fodder cultivators of the Taiyi Sect are also divided into different levels. The newly joined cultivators can be used at will, and even if they are completely consumed, the high-level members of the Taiyi Sect will not feel distressed, at most, Meng Zhang will feel a little reluctant. As for the members of the Hanhai Alliance and the hired loose cultivators from the Jiuqu League, they need to be cherished and cannot be consumed casually. These cannon fodder cultivators, besides the commonly used talismans and magic tools, also have many Mechanical Creations bestowed upon them by the Taiyi Sect. Mechanical Creations like the Rushing Thunder Crossbow and Flaming Blunderbuss do not require the consumption of true qi. They can be easily activated by installing spirit stones. With ample preparation and proper armament, the number of cultivators

mobilized by the Taiyi Sect is far fewer than that of the Flying Swan Sect. However, the pressure they exert on the great formation is not much less.

Especially the Mechanical Creations personally operated by some Taiyi Sect cultivators, specifically designed to attack and defend the great formation. For example, the Shocking Thunder Cannon can be activated from a far distance from the mountain protection great formation. Each activation produces a thunderous sound and shoots out lightning-like spheres, heavily striking the mountain protection great formation. There is also the Mountain-Crushing War Chariot, dozens of zhang long and nearly ten zhang high. Controlled by Taiyi Sect cultivators, it charges from a distance, crashing onto the mountain protection great formation like a collapsing mountain, causing the protective barrier of the great formation to continuously shake.

As members of the Jiuqu League, Daoist Master Scarlet Flame and the others naturally recognized the Mechanical Creations of the Clever Machine Sect. They secretly cursed the Clever Machine Sect for disregarding the alliance and only caring about earning spirit stones, selling Mechanical Creations to the enemies of the Fire Cloud Sect. In the eyes of Daoist Master Scarlet Flame, a Gold Core Daoist Master, he had never held the Clever Machine Sect's Mechanical Creations in high regard. He believed that these clever devices were of no help in enhancing a cultivator's cultivation base. If low-level cultivators became obsessed with these things, it would only hinder their cultivation progress. These devices may appear powerful, but they can only show their might among low-level cultivators.

Now, these Mechanical Creations have fallen into the hands of the Taiyi Sect and have unexpectedly played a significant role, posing a great threat to the mountain protection great formation. Seeing how useful the Clever Machine Sect's Mechanical Creations are, both the Flying Swan Sect and the Northern Desert Qi Family are preparing to purchase them from the Clever Machine Sect. In the absence of available stock, they even shamelessly request that the Taiyi Sect share some with them.

Now, everyone is like grasshoppers on the same rope, all striving for the same goal. Meng Zhang made an effort and provided them with a batch. The Divine Workshop of the Taiyi Sect has developed well. Not only can it maintain many Mechanical Creations purchased from the Clever Machine Sect, but it also has a certain refining ability to produce some relatively simple items. Because Meng Zhang values the manufacturing ability of the mechanical engineers, and the sect does not lack their combat power, the cultivators of the Divine Workshop rarely participate in battles.

In this major battle, the stored Mechanical Creations of the sect were quickly depleted. The cultivators of the Divine Workshop exerted all their efforts. In addition to daily maintenance, they also desperately refined Mechanical Creations to provide assistance to the frontline army as much as possible.

The attack on Feihong Mountain continues relentlessly, and the losses of the three factions are becoming increasingly heavy. After suffering significant losses among the cannon fodder cultivators, the three factions have no choice but to send their core disciples onto the battlefield, despite their reluctance. Although the use of Mechanical Creations has reduced the losses on the attacking side, after more than a month of siege, not only have most of the cannon fodder

cultivators suffered heavy losses, but the core disciples of the three factions have also been seriously injured or killed.

Of course, all these lives sacrificed have not been in vain. The details of the Blazing Flames Overturning Earth Great Formation have been mostly figured out by the four Gold Core Daoist Masters. Even the Third Rank mountain protection great formation is not indestructible. After prolonged high-load operation, even if the great formation can still hold on, many parts within the great formation have started to have problems. The three factions have finally caused some damage to the great formation after paying such a high price.

Now, the situation depends on who can continue to bear the losses and persist until the end. Will it be the depletion of the lives of the three factions or the collapse of the Fire Cloud Sect's mountain protection great formation that comes first?

In addition to the bloody battles taking place on the battlefield, there are also hidden currents and constant struggles off the battlefield. The Clever Machine Sect, which has been selling Mechanical Creations to the Taiyi Sect, sent a message through intermediaries stating that their trade with the Taiyi Sect would be temporarily suspended. They will no longer sell Mechanical Creations to the Taiyi Sect, and all previously placed orders have been canceled.

The Clever Machine Sect, as a Gold Core sect, attaches great importance to its reputation as a big merchant family within the Jiuqu League. To let the Clever Machine Sect forgo earning a large amount of spirit stones and willingly sacrifice their own interests, the pressure behind it can be imagined. Shortly after, Gu Yue Huaidie sent a messenger to inform Meng Zhang of the situation. The Clever Machine Sect was forced to break the agreement due to the intervention of True Monarch Profound Wind. Faced with the pressure of a Primordial Spirit True Monarch, not to mention the Clever Machine Sect, even the Gu Yue Family had to step back. The messenger regretfully informed Meng Zhang that the Gu Yue Family had to temporarily sever ties with the Taiyi Sect and could no longer provide assistance in the future.

And that's not all. Not long after, bad news came from Great Wind City. The city officials announced the suspension of all transactions with the Taiyi Sect, Flying Swan Sect, and Northern Desert Qi Family.

Chapter 524: Interrupt

The official of Great Wind City prohibits the commercial caravans of Flying Swan City and two other forces from going to Great Wind City for shopping. Before the war ends, no commercial caravans from Great Wind City are allowed to step into the Endless Sea of Sand.

The regulations of the Great Wind City officials are very detailed and leave no room for any loopholes, effectively blocking all external trading channels for the three forces.

Great Wind City is the nearest major trading city to the Endless Sea of Sand, making it difficult for the caravans from the Endless Sea of Sand to bypass Great Wind City and continue trading in other parts of the Jiuqu League. Even if they enter the Jiuqu League, it is unlikely that any force would risk offending a Primordial Spirit True Monarch for just a small business deal.

As one of the prominent trading cities in the Jiuqu League, Great Wind City holds a significant position. If it had a Primordial Spirit True Monarch, it would have become one of the top forces in the Jiuqu League long ago.

For True Monarch Profound Wind to subdue Great Wind City, it would also require a considerable amount of effort. He raises the banner of unity within the Jiuqu League, emphasizing the alliance and claiming that Great Wind City and Fire Cloud Sect are both members of the Jiuqu League and should support each other. If Great Wind City trades with the enemies of Fire Cloud Sect, it would be considered aiding the enemy.

Apart from using these righteous excuses for moral coercion, True Monarch Profound Wind has also done a lot of work behind the scenes.

Although the Lu Family and Gu Yue Family, who are in charge of Great Wind City, do not have a Primordial Spirit True Monarch, with their background, they can find a Primordial Spirit True Monarch to help them. However, the favor of a Primordial Spirit True Monarch is extremely valuable, and they are unwilling to use their family's trump cards for just the trade from the Endless Sea of Sand. The benefits brought by the forces like Flying Swan Sect are not worth the risk of offending a Primordial Spirit True Monarch.

The severance of trade between Great Wind City and the Endless Sea of Sand has had a significant impact. The war in the Cultivation World also places great importance on logistics, with significant consumption of various war supplies. The three forces now consume a large amount of pills, talismans, mechanical creations, and more every day. Losing the supplies from Great Wind City, they can only rely on their own stockpile for a limited time.

Among the three forces, Flying Swan Sect has the deepest background and once had the most powerful production capacity in the entire Endless Sea of Sand. However, after experiencing multiple disasters, even their mountain gate was lost, and most of their production capacity dissipated. Although Flying Swan Sect left some cultivators to stay in Yellow Sand Ridge, and these cultivators work day and night to produce various necessary supplies, their meager production capacity is far from enough to meet the frontline consumption.

Taiyi Sect's flaw is that it has risen too recently, and its foundation is too shallow. The internal production system developed by Meng Zhang with full effort is only in its infancy and far from enough to support such a large-scale war.

As for the Qi Family in the Northern Desert, it goes without saying. Being in the remote and barren area of the Northern Desert, the most desolate part of the Endless Sea of Sand, they rely on the blood transfusion from Qi Mingyun True Monarch to survive. The entire family's production capacity still cannot catch up with Taiyi Sect at present.

Originally, the three forces thought they would have more than three months to conquer Feihong Mountain. However, with True Monarch Profound Wind causing such a disturbance, the war supplies of the three forces can only support them for another two months at most. Furthermore, since True Monarch Profound Wind has already made a move, it is likely that things are not as simple as they seem. They fear that he may have some follow-up measures that they cannot withstand.

Their biggest hope now is for True Monarch Tian Zhu to intervene in time. However, when True Monarch Tian Zhu will make a move and how the Primordial Spirit True Monarchs will compete

with each other is beyond their interference. The only thing the four Gold Core Daoist Masters can do is to continue fighting and strengthen their attack on Feihong Mountain.

The situation is dire, and at this time, the three forces dare not hold back and have brought out their last resources.

Originally, several Guardian Spirit Generals of Taiyi Sect were staying at the mountain gate to refine the Heaven and Earth Spiritual Objects. However, when the sect urgently needed combat power, Meng Zhang had to call them over.

Except for Delicate Water Spirit General, who was refining the Tianyi True Water at a critical moment and couldn't leave, the other three Guardian Spirit Generals quickly arrived at the battlefield.

Among the Heaven and Earth Spiritual Objects bestowed by True Monarch Tian Zhu, besides the Tianyi True Water being refined by Delicate Water Spirit General, there are two spiritual objects for Shocking Thunder Spirit General and Extreme Sword Spirit General to refine.

The two Guardian Spirit Generals who successfully refined the Heaven and Earth Spiritual Objects have made significant progress in their cultivation bases. Shocking Thunder Spirit General is still a bit short of fully recovering to the Gold Core stage, while Extreme Sword Spirit General has restored their cultivation base to the completion of the Foundation Building stage.

Deep Earth Spirit General had already restored their cultivation base to the completion of the Foundation Building stage. Recently, they have been overseeing the repair of the Third Rank spirit vein in the Crow's Nest area.

After a period of repair work, which required a lot of manpower and resources, they finally achieved some small results.

After receiving Meng Zhang's message, Deep Earth Spirit General quickly arrived at the front line with a group of subordinates. Once Deep Earth Spirit General arrived at the front line, Meng Zhang specifically consulted them to see if there was a better way to break the Blazing Flames Overturning Earth Great Formation set up by the Fire Cloud Sect.

As a Geomancer, Deep Earth Spirit General has a deep understanding of formations. Moreover, as a former Gold Core expert, they are familiar with Third Rank guardian formations.

Although Wen Qiansun, the formation expert in the sect, has a high level of formation attainment, they are limited to the Foundation Building stage and have no way to deal with a Third Rank guardian formation.

When attacking the Forest Spring Watch mountain gate, Deep Earth Spirit General used the method of severing the earth veins to break a Second Rank guardian formation. Meng Zhang now wants to know if Deep Earth Spirit General can use the same method again and come up with some shortcuts to break the formation.

Deep Earth Spirit General spent some time carefully surveying and exploring the surroundings of Feihong Mountain, pondering for a long time.

Finally, they told Meng Zhang that Feihong Mountain is not like the Forest Spring Watch back then. The earth veins around here are stable, and even if the three forces go all out and spend ten or eight years, they may not be able to sever the earth veins.

Although Deep Earth Spirit General has some unique methods as a Geomancer, they are limited by their current cultivation base and cannot be used.

The Blazing Flames Overturning Earth Great Formation is very sophisticated, with very few flaws. To break the formation, there is probably no other shortcut besides slowly consuming it through direct confrontation.

Since Deep Earth Spirit General said so, Meng Zhang was disappointed but also knew that if they wanted to consume the great formation, they would have to sacrifice lives.

Deep Earth Spirit General, as one of his trump cards, did not bring him any surprises.

However, the arrival of the three Foundation Building stage completion Guardian Spirit Generals greatly enhanced the combat power of Taiyi Sect.

Although they do not have the strength of the Gold Core stage, they have the vision and experience of Gold Core cultivators. Their significant role on the battlefield far surpasses that of ordinary Foundation Building stage cultivators.

The three forces intensified their attack on Feihong Mountain, resulting in heavy casualties not only among the cannon fodder but also among their own core cultivators.

Although Meng Zhang tried his best to take care of the disciples in the sect, on such a brutal battlefield, Taiyi Sect disciples still suffered significant losses.

Chapter 525: Breaking the Formation . . .

Less than two months remained before the deadline given by True Monarch Tian Zhu, the ultimate stage of their endeavor.

During this period, the three allied forces had launched relentless attacks, sparing no expense and disregarding all losses. Although they achieved some success, the costs they incurred were tremendous.

The depletion of materials was one thing, but the human toll was unbearable to witness. The majority of the cannon-fodder cultivators had been lost, and those who remained were mostly severely wounded. Even those lucky enough to be unharmed had lost all morale, wandering listlessly like the walking dead.

The core cultivators from the three forces suffered devastating losses as well. In the Taiyi Sect alone, despite the deliberate protection of three Guardian Spirit Generals, the casualties were substantial, with several Foundation Building cultivators falling in battle.

Now, within the Taiyi Sect, mid-stage Foundation Building cultivators were qualified to vie for positions of elders. The loss of several at this level was a crippling blow, despite the sect's recent advancement to Gold Core status, which still left the number of Foundation Building cultivators limited.

Fortunately, the losses were primarily among guest cultivators. The direct disciples favored by Meng Zhang had been carefully preserved.

The Fire Cloud Sect's cultivators had largely been spared, and their Third Rank protective mountain formation, the Flaming Ground Array, had not been fundamentally breached.

If the battle continued in this vein, even if the cultivators of the three forces bled themselves dry, they would not overcome the Fire Cloud Sect entrenched on Feihong Mountain.

A First Rank Formation Breaking Talisman might still be purchasable with enough spirit stones, but acquiring a Second Rank Formation Breaking Talisman becomes much more challenging. A Third Rank Formation Breaking Talisman, in contrast, is considered a critical strategic resource, scarcely seen on the open market.

In the Taiyi Sect, Talisman Master Yang Xueyi and Formation Master Wen Qiansun had once collaborated in crafting Formation Breaking Talismans. They exerted immense effort and resources to produce only a few Second Rank talismans.

The success rate of crafting these talismans is exceptionally low, and the cost, in terms of materials, is prohibitive—making it an economically unfeasible venture.

However, the value of Formation Breaking Talismans cannot be measured solely in spirit stones.

Before the onset of war, the three major powers had foreseen the necessity of breaching a Third Rank protective mountain great formation. They expended significant efforts attempting to acquire Third Rank Formation Breaking Talismans, but neither the profound Flying Swan Sect nor the Taiyi Sect, closely affiliated with the Gu Yue Family, met with success.

After they began their assault on the Blazing Flames Overturning Earth Great Formation, Meng Zhang solicited the Gu Yue Family's assistance once again.

Whether the Gu Yue Family was unwilling to help or simply incapable, Meng Zhang consistently failed to acquire a Third Rank Formation Breaking Talisman.

Even Jin Li, a Daoist Master in the late stage of the Gold Core cultivation, lacked the means to obtain such talismans. The two she possessed were treasures from True Monarch Tian Zhu's collection.

Initially helpless against the Third Rank protective mountain formation known as the Blazing Flames Overturning Earth Great Formation, the four Gold Core Daoist Masters found their spirits revitalized and their fighting will reignited upon seeing the treasures Jin Li produced.

In recent days, while Meng Zhang and others engaged in fierce battles, Jin Li was not idle.

There would undoubtedly be animosity from the conscripted cultivators and the forces they represent toward the Flying Swan Sect. However, the sect's leadership was undeterred.

Having ruled the Endless Sea of Sand for so many years, had the Flying Swan Sect not amassed its share of adversaries? How many had cursed and loathed them? Yet, had any of them genuinely harmed the sect?

In the Cultivation World, power always reigns supreme. Even if maligned by multitudes, so what?

Unless there exists a force capable of opposing the Flying Swan Sect, they would continue to be oppressed, with rebellion remaining a mere dream.

Both Meng Zhang and the Taiyi Sect, recent risers to power, lacked the cunning tactics of the experienced Flying Swan Sect. Moreover, Meng Zhang always maintained a moral boundary, refusing to resort to any means necessary.

Upon their return to Demon Wind Gobi, the entire Taiyi Sect was licking its wounds.

Meng Zhang harbored a lingering concern. He had inflicted significant damage on Daoist Master Fiery Cloud and later personally dismantled the Blazing Flames Overturning Earth Great Formation, thereby becoming the primary cause of the Fire Cloud Sect's defeat.

He had now become mortal enemies with the Fire Cloud Sect, severing all ties. Any previous connection with Daoist Master Scarlet Flame had evaporated.

Becoming adversaries with an established Gold Core sect like the Fire Cloud Sect would inevitably bring future complications. Thankfully, the Flying Swan Sect bore the brunt of most issues.

After rewarding his sect's cultivators, allowing all disciples to rest, many interrupted tasks were resumed.

Subordinates of the Taiyi Sect in the Endless Sea of Sand expedited their migration to Demon Wind Gobi. The environment there was more hospitable for human survival and ideal for cultivators.

Grand Lion Ridge became the new entrance for the Taiyi Sect. Construction and development projects there began in full swing.

Deep Earth Spirit General resumed repairing the Third Rank spirit vein near the raven's nest. Meng Zhang increased his support, permitting him to mobilize more resources.

The Hundred Grass Pavilion urgently needed a Third Rank spirit vein, whereas the one at Grand Lion Ridge was sufficient only for Meng Zhang's personal cultivation.

Upon returning to the Northern Desert, Qi Nanfei Daoist Master indeed dispatched covert envoys to Demon Wind Gobi to establish regular communication with the Taiyi Sect.

Given the current situation in the Endless Sea of Sand, the Flying Swan Sect was unable to continue its campaign against the Taiyi Sect and Northern Desert Qi Family. Moreover, due to the easing relations between True Monarch Tian Zhu and Qi Mingyuan True Monarch, there was no need to target the Northern Desert Qi Family for eradication.

However, among the Taiyi Sect, Northern Desert Qi Family, and Flying Swan Sect, with one being dominant and the other two weaker, the two weaker factions naturally allied against the dominant force.

Chapter 528: Business

Between Taiyi Sect and Northern Desert Qi Family, even though there seems to be a faint alliance when facing Flying Swan Sect, they still maintain a high level of caution towards each other. To avoid provoking Flying Swan Sect, the two factions refrain from overt interactions on the surface. In the current state of the Endless Sea of Sand, the possibility of an internal war breaking out is small, so the alliance between Taiyi Sect and Northern Desert Qi Family is more of a precautionary measure.

However, Meng Zhang's primary focus has shifted beyond the Endless Sea of Sand. After the defeat of Fire Cloud Sect and the conclusion of the war, True Monarch Profound Wind, the mastermind behind Fire Cloud Sect, has remained inactive for the time being. Yet, trade between Great Wind City and Endless Sea of Sand has not immediately resumed, and this is certainly not the intention of Great Wind City.

Great Wind City became a major trading hub largely due to its strategic location, situated at the crossroads of the Northern Desert and the core region of Jiuqu League. It faces the vast sea to the west and boundless grasslands to the east. The various special resources produced in the Endless Sea of Sand are mainly exported to Great Wind City, while the city continually supplies a variety of cultivation resources to the Endless Sea of Sand.

Especially after Taiyi Sect took control of a large area in the Demon Wind Gobi, they began acquiring the resources from the region and selling them in Great Wind City. Losing this trade would result in a decline of at least thirty percent in the overall trading scale of Great Wind City. Naturally, Great Wind City is unwilling to permanently lose these benefits. While True Monarch Profound Wind is not someone to be trifled with, the interests at stake cannot be easily abandoned.

During the invasion of Fire Cloud Sect into the Endless Sea of Sand, Great Wind City, according to the will of True Monarch Profound Wind, cut off all trades with the region. Even though the war has now ended, they must still consider the face of Primordial Spirit True Monarch. Great Wind City has not publicly resumed trade with the Endless Sea of Sand, but a large number of smugglers have suddenly emerged in the border areas between the two regions, engaging in secret trade activities.

Between the Demon Wind Gobi and Great Wind City, where the border is not too long, there are also many smuggler caravans appearing. Last time, when Meng Zhang hired many loose cultivators from Great Wind City to participate in the war in the Endless Sea of Sand, they suffered heavy casualties. However, after the war, Meng Zhang honored his promises and generously rewarded those who survived and even distributed the promised rewards to the families and friends of the deceased cultivators as per their wishes.

Though this placed a heavy financial burden on Taiyi Sect, it also brought numerous benefits. Many of the surviving loose cultivators expressed their willingness to continue serving Taiyi Sect. Some of them who were familiar with the situation in Jiuqu League joined the smuggling caravans dispatched by Taiyi Sect.

The reputation of Taiyi Sect, known for keeping its promises, gradually spread in Jiuqu League. Reputation, though intangible, can have unexpected impacts at certain times. A sect known for its reliability and honesty in dealings with other forces and in commercial exchanges will enjoy many intangible conveniences.

Officially, Great Wind City has not restored its trade with Taiyi Sect, Flying Swan Sect, and others. However, through these smuggling caravans, trade has partially resumed. Gu Yue Family also secretly sent envoys to Grand Lion Ridge to visit Meng Zhang and express the family's apologies.

The envoy was Gu Yue Youlan, an acquaintance of Meng Zhang. She humbly explained the difficulties faced by the family in the past to express the family's remorse. As compensation, Gu Yue Family was willing to reduce a portion of the interest on the large amount of spirit stones borrowed from Taiyi Sect using the resources of the Demon Wind Gobi. They also extended the repayment period and offered more benefits in their business dealings.

When Gu Yue Family had previously decided to sever ties with Taiyi Sect, Meng Zhang understood but was somewhat unable to accept it. He had thought that Gu Yue Family, especially due to his friendship with Gu Yue Huaidie, would be a reliable friend of Taiyi Sect. Now, it seems he had set his expectations too high. In the face of the pressure from Primordial Spirit True Monarch, there were no truly reliable friends.

This incident served as a lesson for Meng Zhang, making him understand that in the Cultivation World, relationships between different factions cannot be sustained solely based on personal emotions. With cultivators like Gu Yue Youlan, who came from major families, it was difficult for Meng Zhang, as a Gold Core Daoist Master with the Mind Reading Divine Ability, to read their thoughts. They either practiced Heart-Locking Secret Arts or carried magic tools that prevented others from reading their minds, making it hard for Meng Zhang to determine the truth of what they said.

Regardless of Gu Yue Huaidie's attitude, from now on, Meng Zhang will be more cautious and secretly strengthen Taiyi Sect's defenses against Gu Yue Family. As the lord of a sect, regardless of his thoughts, Meng Zhang must still prioritize Taiyi Sect's interests outwardly. He expressed magnanimity, indicating that he bears no grudges against Gu Yue Family for their past difficulties and showed full understanding. Gu Yue Youlan and he had a good relationship since he was a Foundation Building cultivator, and he would never blame an old friend like her. Gu Yue Huaidie, as his senior, had provided significant help, and Meng Zhang never forgot it. Regardless of any unpleasant past between Gu Yue Family and Taiyi Sect, Gu Yue Huaidie would always be Meng Zhang's closest friend.

In front of Gu Yue Youlan, Meng Zhang displayed no pride as a Gold Core Daoist Master and maintained a friendly and equal demeanor. Naturally, Meng Zhang hoped for a swift restoration of interactions between Taiyi Sect and Gu Yue Family. Gu Yue Youlan was satisfied with Meng Zhang's attitude and had achieved the purpose of her visit.

Despite being only a Foundation Building cultivator, Gu Yue Youlan was Gu Yue Huaidie's disciple and the next generation Diviner groomed by the family. Within Gu Yue Family, her status was just below that of Gold Core elders. A Gold Core sect like Taiyi Sect, which had only one Gold Core Daoist Master, would not have been given much attention by her if not for Meng Zhang's relationship.

For Meng Zhang, Gu Yue Family was vastly different from Taiyi Sect. Although they might not be dependable, he still had to strive to hold onto this valuable connection. With Taiyi Sect occupying a

large area in the Demon Wind Gobi and having abundant resources, many families in Great Wind City saw Taiyi Sect as having significant development potential.

Jiuqu League had long been coveting the resources of the Demon Wind Gobi. However, in the past, no force dared to invade due to the association with True Monarch Tian Zhu, who was seen as controlling the Endless Sea of Sand, Demon Wind Gobi, and Deadly Sea of Sand.

The recent events proved that seemingly neutral trade hubs like Great Wind City could not be relied upon in crucial times. Taiyi Sect could not entrust its trade lifeline solely to Great Wind City. The next step for Taiyi Sect was to find ways to open new trade routes, but this task was easier said than done.

To the north was the Deadly Sea of Sand, which had no trade prospects. In the northeast was Northern Desert Qi Family. While they sought to repair their relations with Taiyi Sect, their territory was barren, and they lacked substantial production capacity to be of much help to Taiyi Sect. However, due to Taiyi Sect's strength and the resources of the Demon Wind Gobi, Northern Desert Qi Family still sought trade cooperation.

To the east was Flying Swan Sect, with overlapping resource production, but mutual exchange between the two was minimal. After experiencing significant changes, Flying Swan Sect's production capacity had greatly diminished. The trade with them did not provide much assistance to Taiyi Sect. Further east, there was a boundary with the vast grasslands. Trade with the grasslands was a forbidden area for Flying Swan Sect and not accessible to outsiders. freewebnovel.com

To the west was the remaining part of the Demon Wind Gobi, still dominated by demonic beasts, including Third Rank ones. Given Taiyi Sect's current strength, it was already challenging enough to defend against those demonic beasts, let alone expand in that direction. Moreover, the current discussion was about the sect's trade issues, not its next expansion direction. There could be no trade with those demonic beasts.

After much discussion, it became evident that Taiyi Sect had to find a way within Jiuqu League to open up new trade routes.

Chapter 529: Good News

Great Wind City is considered a formidable force within the Jiuqu League, and its influence makes others wary of offending it easily. The official authorities and major cultivation families of Great Wind City are currently the primary trade partners for Taiyi Sect. Naturally, they do not want to see Taiyi Sect establishing new trade routes.

For Taiyi Sect to bypass Great Wind City and find new trading partners within the Jiuqu League is undoubtedly not an easy task. Taiyi Sect's current relationships are mostly concentrated within Great Wind City and are of no help in such matters.

Meng Zhang shares a good rapport with Luo YeDaoist Master from the black market. However, such personal relationships do not have a decisive impact on the interaction between their respective factions. While Luo YeDaoist Master holds some influence in the black market of Jiuqu League, they are not the main decision-makers.

Luo YeDaoist Master had previously warned Meng Zhang that although the black market may seem cooperative, they are untrustworthy and can turn against others for their benefit.

If Taiyi Sect were to secretly contact the black market without involving Great Wind City, the most likely outcome is that the black market would betray Taiyi Sect to gain favor with the more powerful Great Wind City.

In addition, Meng Zhang had minor dealings with Jade Sword Sect in the past, but their relationship is insignificant. Jade Sword Sect, being a Sword Cultivator sect, holds a unique position within the Jiuqu League and cannot be relied upon by Taiyi Sect in this matter.

With no direct channels available, Taiyi Sect must patiently search for new avenues. They must not only avoid arousing suspicions from Great Wind City but also keep their activities concealed from Gu Yue Family.

For several years, Luo YeDaoist Master's disciple, Jue Ying, has been staying in Demon Wind Gobi, teaching An Moran various skills and assisting him in establishing and developing Secret Hall.

During the recent joint battle of the three forces against Fire Cloud Sect, Meng Zhang asked Jue Ying to stay in Demon Wind Gobi to help Taiyi Sect guard their territory.

Jue Ying has been with Taiyi Sect for quite some time, and she is preparing to leave. As a gesture of gratitude for her significant help, Meng Zhang entrusted her with an important task.

He selected two clever individuals from the Foundation Building stage of cultivation within Taiyi Sect and asked them to accompany Jue Ying to Jiuqu League. Their mission is to familiarize themselves with the situation in Jiuqu League under Jue Ying's guidance and slowly search for new trading partners.

If possible, they should also try to establish a branch of Secret Hall in Jiuqu League under An Moran's leadership, arrange informants, and gather various information.

After dealing with these matters, Meng Zhang can focus his primary energy back on his cultivation.

Meng Zhang's main cultivation technique, "Sun-Moon Wheel Turning Sutra," encompasses the entire journey from the Refining Qi stage to the Gold Core stage. He doesn't need to worry too much about his cultivation during the early, mid, or late stages of Gold Core.

The valuable experiences gained from exchanges with Gu Yue Huaidie and Luo YeDaoist Master have greatly benefited his cultivation.

After the awakening of the Extreme Sword Spirit General, Meng Zhang has actively sought his advice several times and gained significant insights and useful experiences.

The Third-Rank spirit vein at Grand Lion Ridge provides more than enough spiritual energy for him to cultivate alone.

Multiple battles with opponents at the Gold Core stage not only improved his combat experience but also deepened his understanding of his cultivation technique.

Just a few years after the battle to reclaim Feihong Mountain, Meng Zhang successfully advanced to the mid-stage of Gold Core at the age of one hundred and nine.

His cultivation speed remained swift, even after entering the Gold Core stage, which earned him a respectable position among Gold Core Daoist Masters.

Many Gold Core Daoist Masters, like Qin Hongying, a former guest of Taiyi Sect, could only reach the early stage of Gold Core until their lifespan was nearly depleted.

Meng Zhang's breakthrough to the mid-stage of Gold Core at this age truly marked him as a promising young cultivator.

With the advancement to the mid-stage of Gold Core, Meng Zhang's demand for spiritual energy from the heavens and earth increased significantly. At this point, the supply of spiritual energy from the Third-Rank spirit vein at Grand Lion Ridge was slightly inadequate.

Once established, the Hundred Grass Pavilion began operating autonomously. Besides a tall tower, there is also a spirit medicine garden covering an area of over one hundred acres.

Currently, Taiyi Sect has nearly forty Foundation Building stage cultivators. Other forces within the Hanhai Alliance have also benefited greatly. Those close to Taiyi Sect can purchase Lesser

Foundation Building Pills from them. Traditional allies like Qiaoshou Sect even have the privilege to purchase Foundation Building Pills.

Throughout the Hanhai Alliance, apart from Taiyi Sect, there are over thirty Foundation Building stage cultivators. The presence of numerous Foundation Building stage cultivators not only solidifies the foundation of the Hanhai Alliance but also accelerates the development of Demon Wind Gobi. Moreover, having a sufficient number of Foundation Building stage cultivators allows them to set up special formations to resist the power of Gold Core Daoist Masters.

Additionally, the spirit medicine garden contains many Third Rank spirit medicines. Once Taiyi Sect has a Third Rank Alchemist, they will be able to refine Third Rank spirit pills that are useful for Gold Core Daoist Masters.

Less than two years after Meng Zhang broke through to the mid-stage of Gold Core, Delicate WaterSpirit General, who had been in seclusion refining the Tianyi True Water, finally came out of seclusion.

After coming out of seclusion, Delicate WaterSpirit General's Cultivation Base had restored to the early stage of Gold Core.

Among the four Guardian Spirit Generals, Delicate WaterSpirit General was the second to awaken, with far fewer years of experience compared to Deep EarthSpirit General and Shocking ThunderSpirit General. Yet, she was the first one to restore her Cultivation Base to the Gold Core stage.

This result had both innate and fortuitous reasons. If it weren't for the small bottle of Tianyi True Water obtained from True Monarch Tian Zhu, Delicate WaterSpirit General's return to the Gold Core stage would have remained a distant dream.

The other three Guardian Spirit Generals considered Delicate WaterSpirit General's return to the Gold Core stage as a matter of course. According to what Shocking ThunderSpirit General privately told Meng Zhang, Delicate WaterSpirit General was once the top cultivator of Taiyi Sect after its reconstruction. With a Cultivation Base at the Gold Corelate stage, she was the pillar of the sect.

However, an accident led to her losing all hope of breaking through to the Primordial Spirit stage. Later, she voluntarily transformed into a Guardian Spirit General, and her Cultivation Base fell to the early stage of Gold Core.

While her return to the early stage of Gold Core was significant, Delicate WaterSpirit General didn't find it a reason to be happy. But for these Guardian Spirit Generals, who were once strong Gold Core Daoist Masters, transforming into Guardian Spirit Generals with only the early stage of Gold Core was not something to be happy about.

Transforming from Gold Core Daoist Masters to Guardian Spirit Generals was not a simple task and had a high failure rate. Otherwise, Taiyi Sect would have continuously produced Guardian Spirit Generals.

Due to the extremely low success rate of transformation, Guardian Spirit Generals became precious and rare. Because Delicate WaterSpirit General had a Cultivation Base at the early stage of Gold Core before, her restoration to Cultivation Base didn't cause any significant changes, unlike when Foundation Building stage cultivators breakthrough to the Gold Core stage.

After recovering her Cultivation Base, Delicate WaterSpirit General hasn't interacted with anyone in the sect. Only the other three Guardian Spirit Generals know about it.

After discussing with the three Guardian Spirit Generals, Meng Zhang decided to temporarily keep this news sealed and use Delicate WaterSpirit General as a hidden trump card for Taiyi Sect.

Externally, including other cultivators in Taiyi Sect, it is strictly confidential. They only mention that Delicate WaterSpirit General is still in seclusion and has not come out yet. freewebnovël.com

For Foundation Building stage cultivators, going into seclusion for decades is not uncommon.

While Delicate WaterSpirit General's recovery to the Gold Core stage is a great thing, it has also brought a new problem.

The Third Rank spirit vein of Grand Lion Ridge was barely enough to support Meng Zhang alone, and now with the addition of Delicate WaterSpirit General, the spiritual energy was even more insufficient. The task of repairing the spirit vein by Deep EarthSpirit General was far from completion.

During regular days, Delicate WaterSpirit General tried to avoid absorbing the spiritual energy from the Third Rank spirit vein and instead used high-grade spiritual stones to set up gathering formations. As a Guardian Spirit General, her Cultivation Base was already difficult to advance. As long as she could barely maintain her daily cultivation and preserve her Cultivation Base from falling, it was considered satisfactory.

Meng Zhang knew that this was not a long-term solution. The vast consumption of high-grade spiritual stones by Delicate WaterSpirit General was a heavy burden on the entire sect. Furthermore, he, as well as the other Spirit Generals, hoped that Delicate WaterSpirit General would continue to progress in her Cultivation Base.

Among the young disciples of Taiyi Sect, individuals like Wen Qiansun and Yang Xueyi, with exceptional talent, had already reached the late stage of Foundation Building. Their breakthrough to the Gold Core stage was not far off.

Currently, Taiyi Sect's demand for the Third Rank spirit vein became an unavoidable issue. Throughout the Endless Sea of Sand, there were no unclaimed Third Rank spirit veins. Northern Desert Qi Family had one, but it seemed to have some significant flaws. Besides, Northern Desert

Qi Family was a potential ally, and Taiyi Sect couldn't possibly have hostile intentions towards them.

Flying Swan Sect had the best conditions, possessing two Third Rank spirit veins. Especially the Third Rank spirit vein in Feihong Mountain, which was originally owned by the Primordial Spirit sect, Purple Gold Sect, and had excellent quality.

Even if Flying Swan Sect currently only had two Gold Core Daoist Masters, even if they had a few more, the spiritual energy provided by that Third Rank spirit vein would still be more than enough.

Unfortunately, from all perspectives, Taiyi Sect couldn't take action against Flying Swan Sect right now.

As for the remaining areas in Demon Wind Gobi, firstly, it was uncertain whether there were any Third Rank spirit veins, and secondly, there were many Third Rank demon beasts within, making it difficult to clear them out.

After much thought, Meng Zhang came up with the only feasible solution: to return to the Deadly Sea of Sand and try to obtain the spirit essence once again. However, this time, he wouldn't go personally.

He had heard from Jin LiDaoist Master that the Deadly Sea of Sand was the battleground where the Fifth Rank great power and True Monarch Tian Zhu contended. The Fifth Rank great power kept a keen eye on the Deadly Sea of Sand through numerous sand monsters.

Foundation Building stage cultivators entering the Deadly Sea of Sand might not draw the attention of the Fifth Rank great power. However, Gold Core Daoist Masters had the strength to become pawns in the fight between the Fifth Rank great power and True Monarch Tian Zhu.

So, once a Gold Core Daoist Master entered the Deadly Sea of Sand, they would quickly be discovered by the Fifth Rank great power, attracting a continuous pursuit from sand monsters. Even if they managed to escape the chase of the sand monsters, the Fifth Rank great power might personally take action at the cost of some price.

This was also the reason why other Gold Core Daoist Masters didn't dare to enter the Deadly Sea of Sand.

Jin LiDaoist Master dared to enter and leave the Deadly Sea of Sand because he had an agreement with True Monarch Tian Zhu. Besides, within the Deadly Sea of Sand, he couldn't take the initiative to act.

Meng Zhang decided to select a group of elite Taiyi Sect Foundation Building stage cultivators and let them go to the Deadly Sea of Sand. This would be a kind of training for them, and they could also attempt to seize the spirit essence.

In fact, Taiyi Sect, along with other cultivators of the Hanhai Alliance, mainly focused on training in Demon Wind Gobi.

However, as the surrounding demon beasts were hunted in large numbers, Foundation Building stage cultivators found it increasingly difficult to gain sufficient training.

The other Foundation Building stage cultivators in the Hanhai Alliance could afford to be less concerned, but if Taiyi Sect cultivators had aspirations to break through to the Gold Core stage, various trials were inevitable.

Chapter 530: Informed and Experienced

In the current Taiyi Sect, many cultivators secretly enter the territory of the Jiuqu League through the channels of those smugglers and then travel around the area. The Great Wind City officials turn a blind eye to such activities. Even in the capacity of True Monarch Profound Wind, it is impossible to constantly monitor the lower-level Taiyi Sect cultivators.

The Fire Cloud Sect is occupied with tending to their wounds and cannot spare the attention. Moreover, within the Jiuqu League's jurisdiction, the Fire Cloud Sect cannot freely hunt other cultivators. Therefore, as long as these lower-level Taiyi Sect cultivators are not extremely unlucky or deliberately causing trouble, their safety within the Jiuqu League's territory is reasonably assured.

For Meng Zhang to use the Deadly Sea of Sand as a new training ground for Foundation Building stage cultivators from Taiyi Sect, there is a lot of preparation work to be done. These cultivators must undergo targeted training before entering the Deadly Sea of Sand to ensure their survival.

In addition, Meng Zhang also asked Jin Qiao'er to take care of these Taiyi Sect cultivators entering the Deadly Sea of Sand. Jin LiDaoist Master spends a significant amount of time within the Deadly Sea of Sand. While she may not be able to actively intervene, she can still find ways to assist these Taiyi Sect cultivators if she is willing.

When Meng Zhang spoke to Jin Qiao'er about this matter, Jin Qiao'er showed great interest. She herself had experienced multiple trials on the fringes of the Deadly Sea of Sand. Initially, Jin LiDaoist Master scolded her a few times, but as Jin Qiao'er gained more combat experience and improved her self-defense abilities, Jin LiDaoist Master stopped bothering her.

Although she rarely ventured deep into the Deadly Sea of Sand, Jin Qiao'er was very familiar with the situation inside. The Third Rank sand monsters within the Deadly Sea of Sand are mostly found around that Fifth Rank great power and rarely roam freely. As long as the teams of Foundation Building stage cultivators are cautious, avoid getting surrounded by sand monsters, and are not targeted by evil cultivators or demonic cultivators, their safety can be ensured.

After a lengthy discussion between Jin Qiao'er and Meng Zhang, she not only agreed to relay the information to her master, Jin LiDaoist Master, but also decided to have some excellent cultivators from the Qiaoshou Sect join in the experience.

Although the Deadly Sea of Sand appears extremely desolate with vast stretches of yellow sand, it is not devoid of resources. Before the arrival of that Fifth Rank great power, the Deadly Sea of Sand was not as desolate as it is today. It had oases, human settlements, cultivation forces, and resources.

After the arrival of the Fifth Rank great power, the cultivation forces within the Deadly Sea of Sand were wiped out, and humans disappeared without a trace. However, the underground mineral resources did not vanish into thin air.

Of course, the few Foundation Building stage cultivators who venture into the Deadly Sea of Sand cannot extensively exploit the various mineral deposits. At most, they can collect some valuable minerals.

In addition, the Deadly Sea of Sand is teeming with countless sand monsters, and there are numerous sand monster nests. Those with courage can venture deep into these nests and obtain valuable Spirit Source Pearls.

Meng Zhang's intention for Taiyi Sect cultivators to undergo this experience is not solely to gather cultivation resources but primarily to give them ample training. Thanks to Jin Qiao'er's active involvement, this matter quickly fell into place. Jin LiDaoist Master agreed to Meng Zhang's request.

However, Jin LiDaoist Master made it clear that she is not their babysitter and cannot look after these cultivators all the time. She can only offer help when convenient. As a reciprocal gesture, Taiyi Sect should also take care of Qiaoshou Sect in the future.

Jin Qiao'er grew up in Qiaoshou Sect but received her inheritance from Jin LiDaoist Master. Jin LiDaoist Master never regarded Qiaoshou Sect, a Foundation Building-level sect, highly and did not want Jin Qiao'er to stay there forever. However, in recent years, Jin Qiao'er has been helping True Monarch Tian Zhu in the Endless Sea of Sand, so she did not leave with Jin LiDaoist Master.

Jin Qiao'er has a deep affection for Qiaoshou Sect, where she grew up. Because of this, Jin LiDaoist Master has been considerate towards Qiaoshou Sect. Being a staunch ally of Taiyi Sect and not a threat to them, Taiyi Sect will treat Qiaoshou Sect well, both out of respect for Jin LiDaoist Master and considering the potential benefits.

Meng Zhang readily agreed to Jin LiDaoist Master's request. Both Meng Zhang and Jin Qiao'er are decisive in their actions, and once the arrangements were made, they immediately set their plan in motion.

Among the Taiyi Sect cultivators are Extreme Sword Spirit General and Shocking Thunder Spirit General at the Foundation Building completion stage, as well as Wen Qiansun and Yang Xueyi at the Foundation Building late stage. Jin Qiao'er represents Qiaoshou Sect at the Foundation Building late stage. These five individuals, as the backbone, will lead the cultivators from both sects and form several teams to take turns exploring the Deadly Sea of Sand.

Delicate Water Spirit General, after recovering her Gold Core stage Cultivation Base, did not want to stay idle within the sect and decided to venture out. As Meng Zhang considers her as a hidden card for the sect, she cannot go to other places in the Cultivation World to avoid revealing her true identity. So, Delicate Water Spirit General chose to venture into the depths of the Demon Wind Gobi alone.

Currently, Taiyi Sect holds a significant portion of the Demon Wind Gobi's territory and has cleared most of the monsters there, firmly controlling the area. There are no Third Rank monsters here, only a few First Rank monsters deliberately kept around and some Second Rank monsters that have escaped the pursuit of human cultivators.

However, moving further into the depths of the Demon Wind Gobi leads to territories still occupied by a large number of monsters, including some Third Rank ones. Taiyi Sect had never paid much attention to the western part of the Demon Wind Gobi after occupying the eastern region.

Meng Zhang knows that there are still a considerable number of monsters in the deep parts of the Demon Wind Gobi, and among them are Third Rank monsters. Until now, these monsters have stayed in the western area and have never come to the east.

Previously, Taiyi Sect's main focus was on the Endless Sea of Sand. Human cultivators, not monsters, posed the biggest threat to Taiyi Sect. The monsters in the deep parts of the Demon Wind Gobi did not pose a threat to Taiyi Sect as they never ventured into the eastern region.

By regularly using this secret method, Meng Zhang could use his own True Essence to gradually nurture the Spiritsnake Spear. From time to time, he added precious materials for refining, allowing the spear to spontaneously integrate and be completely repaired. Extreme Sword Spirit General truly lived up to being the most experienced and knowledgeable senior in Taiyi Sect. After using the secret method for some time, Meng Zhang found it to be quite effective.

Since advancing to Gold Core mid-stage, Meng Zhang converted all his Sun and Moon True Qi into Sun and Moon True Essence, which not only became more pure and abundant but also possessed great spirituality.

While the Endless Sea of Sand and Demon Wind Gobi may lack other resources, they had various mineral deposits. Taiyi Sect derived a considerable income from mining these resources.

With Meng Zhang's status, he could mobilize the entire sect's power to obtain valuable spiritual materials for the refinement of the Spiritsnake Spear. The spear was repaired at a rapid pace, and its power gradually recovered.

Back at Myriad Layers Peak, Meng Zhang and Extreme Sword Spirit General had both obtained some Third Rank magic tools left by Layered Mystery Sect. Meng Zhang stored these magic tools in the sect's treasury for the use of Gold Core cultivators.

During the joint battle against Fire Cloud Sect, when they were still allies, Meng Zhang cautiously probed Fei ShiDaoist Master and Wu Mingwei several times to find out about their gains. But they remained tight-lipped and tried to explore Meng Zhang's gains in return.
