After the tool spirit of many Fourth Rank magic tools undergo transformation, they take on the appearance of young children. This is not a special preference of the magic tool owner but rather conforms to the laws of the heavens.

The transformation of the tool spirit is similar to the growth stages of human children. If a Fourth Rank magic tool goes through long years of growth, its tool spirit's appearance will naturally change over time.

Of course, some tool spirits grow quickly while others grow slowly, and there are many factors that influence this process, making it difficult to enumerate all of them.

Yin Yang Spirit Gourd had been nurtured by Meng Zhang for many years and was a Natal magic tool he cultivated himself.

Its tool spirit naturally felt close to Meng Zhang and was devoted and loyal to him, willing to obey his commands.

After Yin Yang Spirit Gourd advanced to a Fourth Rank magic tool, its power greatly increased, and it acquired many new uses.

Only after the previously nurtured Dao soldiers were used up could it create new ones.

Now, the Dao soldiers nurtured by Yin Yang Spirit Gourd were all at least at the Gold Core stage. Just like before, it could give birth to one Gold Core stage Dao soldier each year, but now the total number increased to twelve.

The most significant change was that it could finally nurture Dao soldiers at the Primordial Spirit stage.

Although the Primordial Spirit stage Dao soldiers it produced had only the initial stage of Primordial Spirit strength, and Meng Zhang could only have two of them at a time, there was a fundamental difference between the Primordial Spirit stage and the Gold Core stage.

Such groups should continue to appear.

As expected, news came in the following days about small groups of Spirit Clan and demon clans appearing in various places.

Especially a group that appeared in the southern region of the Jiuqu League, in Shui Ling, took advantage of the opportunity of weak defense and caused great destruction, moving freely and rampaging around.

After the Dali Dynasty conquered the southern region of the Jiuqu League, to stabilize the situation quickly, they retained many of the original cultivation forces to guard various areas.

These cultivation forces were already dissatisfied with the Dali Dynasty. Not only did their defense slacken, but they were also preoccupied with guarding their own sects.
