She quickly dialed Diana's number. Diana admitted to visiting Leonard but denied taking him away.


"Diana, confront me directly if you have an issue with me. If you dare hurt my brother, I will never forgive you!"

"Have you found your brother?"


"No." Rhonda sounded dejected.

"No, I'm not." Rhonda stubbornly denied it.


"Alright. I hope that's true." As an onlooker, Robert had a clearer perspective and felt a bit disheartened.
