So they don't have another quota for City C. So she had no other choice but to accept the next level contract. She is going to enter Central University 14 in a few days.


When she learnt about the person to whom they had offered an exclusive contract. She was shocked. The person is none other than Jeremy Night.


She knew about his talent right after the awakening ceremony. But body type talents are generally looked down upon by people. Although his talent grade was A Grade.



She can use the ability either herself or boost Lifeline's ability during battle. But what's with the body type talent? It has serious flaws. They can't assist their lifeline beast.


If they want to use their ability, then they have to find a suitable Lifeline beast.
