Lewis and his group eagerly exchanged contact information with Liam, who had no objections about this and was, in fact, pleased.


Having undergone life-and-death situations together with Lewis and the others, Liam trusted them completely.


This was Liam's greatest gain since his arrival in the Cosmic realm.
