They had already given themselves to Liam, meaning they would belong to him for life.

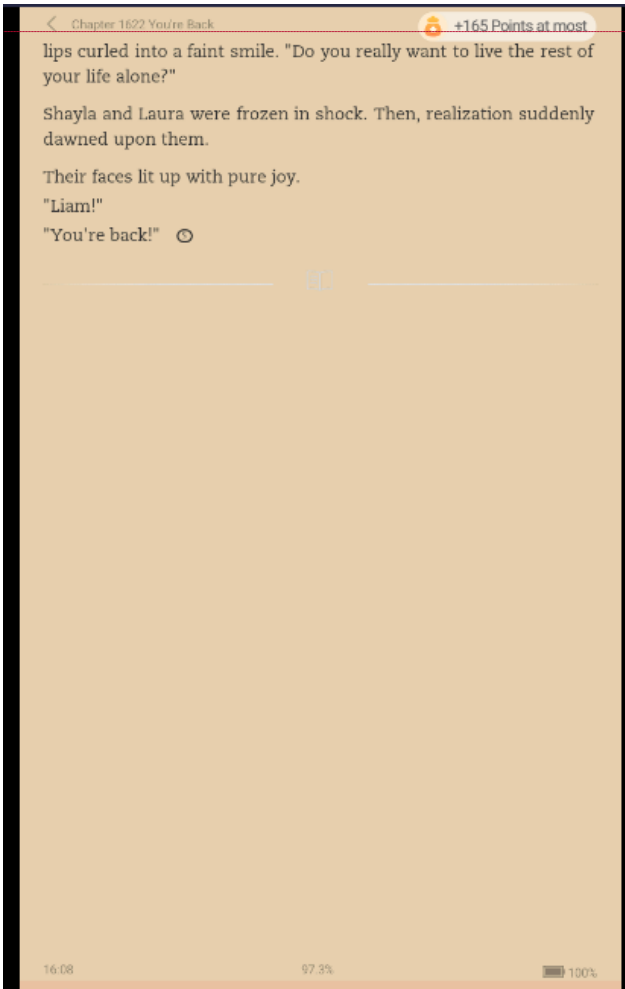
Shayla let out a small laugh. "Looks like we'll both wind up alone."
