Before Shi Feng could stand up from the ground, a series of system notifications entered his ears.

System: You have discovered the Ancient God Graveyard. Starting Tier 4 Abyssal Sword Emperor Promotion Quest.

Quest Content: Obtain the Ancient God Legacy Power in the Ancient God's Graveyard. Rewards unknown.

System: You cannot make contact with the outside world while in the Ancient God Graveyard. If you die in the Ancient God Graveyard, you will be forcibly teleported out of the Ancient God Graveyard, lose ten levels, and have your soul weakened for fifteen days.

So, even with a Legendary Legacy Scroll, I only get one opportunity? What a harsh condition. It seems I can't recklessly take risks now.

Shi Feng didn't know whether to laugh or cry when he finished reading the system notifications.

An Ancient God's Legacy Land!

He didn't think the Legendary Legacy Scroll could teleport him to a Legacy Land related to the Ancient Abyssal God.

However, it would seem that this unbelievable privilege also came at an extraordinary price. Just the penalty for failure was more than enough to ruin him completely.

On top of losing ten levels, he would also have his soul weakened for fifteen days. Should he fail his promotion, he'd need at least a month to return to his current level.

In the current Miniature Ancient World, losing a month's worth of progress was no laughing matter. A God-ranked expert wouldn't necessarily be able to catch up to frontline experts if they doubled their efforts after taking such a loss.

However, what surprised Shi Feng, even more, was the environment in the Ancient God Graveyard.

Mana was the foundation of all life in God's Domain. Yet, there was not a trace of mana in this place...

If the average Tier 3 player were to enter this place, they'd die within 30 seconds. Even players with Epic Mana Bodies shouldn't think of using a single Skill or Spell in such an environment.

As for Shi Feng, his Legendary Mana Body might be capable of producing its own mana. However, in an environment devoid of mana, he could only use Skills and Spells a very limited number of times.

To make matters worse, on top of having no mana whatsoever, the Ancient God Graveyard was also crawling with Level 125, Tier 4 Heroic Spirits...

[Divine Graveyard Wanderer] (Heroic Spirit, Tier 4 Sword Emperor)

Level 125

HP 300,000,000

...

Heroic Spirits were the spirits of deceased Human Heroes. They might not have very high HP and intelligence, but they possessed incredibly high combat standards. Stronger Heroic Spirits would even retain their combat standards when they were alive. In other words, they'd have combat standards of Hero-level NPCs.

Heroes were human NPCs who had received titles and blessings from Gods after accomplishing great deeds that have left even Gods in awe. Even the weakest Hero would have combat power rivaling ordinary Dragons of the same tier. When it came to utilizing Skills and Spells, Heroes were superior to even Domain Realm experts.

It's not going to be possible to engage them one-on-one. It seems I have no choice but to take things slowly. Shi Feng sighed deeply after observing the wandering Heroic Spirits for over an hour. Then, he took out a Magic Tactical Vehicle from his Epic Spatial Bag.

Based on his observation, he found that there should be at least several hundred Tier 4 Heroic Spirits wandering this vast forest shrouded in fog. Moreover, these Heroic Spirits never moved more than 100 yards apart from each other. This meant that should he attack against any of these Heroic Spirits, he would end up attracting the attention of at least three other Heroic Spirits...

Normally, a Tier 3 player would get obliterated if they tried to fight against a Tier 4 Heroic Spirit alone. Although Shi Feng had Tier 4 Physique and Mana, in an environment without mana, he could, at best, defeat a Tier 4 Heroic Spirit in a one-on-one situation. If he had to go up against four Heroic Spirits simultaneously, only death would await him.

The only solution to this problem would be to fight numbers with numbers.

Subsequently, Shi Feng found the closest Divine Graveyard Wanderer and threw a rock at the latter.

Under the acceleration of Shi Feng's Tier 4 Strength, the rock flew forward like a shooting star, penetrated through a tree, and exploded on the Wanderer's back. However, the Wanderer's armor had absorbed most of the impact, so the Wanderer only lost around 9,000 HP, which was an insignificant amount considering he had 300 million HP.

Meanwhile, the struck Wanderer promptly unsheathed his greatsword and left behind an afterimage as he charged at Shi Feng. The Berserker-type Wanderer's speed was so fast that even Tier 4 Assassin experts would be put to shame. In addition, the Wanderer's advance was made without any excess movements. Every movement the Wanderer made thoroughly utilized the forest's complex terrain to let him effectively close the distance while making it hard for Shi Feng to predict the exact trajectory of his approach.

The struck Wanderer wasn't the only one who was approaching Shi Feng. Three other nearby Divine Graveyard Wanderers had also simultaneously charged toward Shi Feng. Moreover, despite not having communicated in any way, the four Wanderers moved with perfect coordination, some approaching

from Shi Feng's blind spots while some distracting Shi Feng with ranged attacks.

You have good coordination, but it's a pity that I'm not alone.

Shi Feng smiled when he saw the four Wanderers entering within 50 yards of him. Then, he promptly injected 2,000 Magic Crystals into the Dragonhorn Tactical Vehicle to activate the Advanced Anti-Magic Barrier and Hexagram Protection simultaneously.

Immediately, the movement of all four Wanderers turned awkward, and none of them could use Tier 4 Skills and Spells any longer. In contrast, Shi Feng's mana was instantly elevated to the Tier 4 standard, even with the restraining effects of the surrounding environment.

Although every attack he landed could only cause around three million damage, he steadily reduced the four Wanderers' HP.

In less than a minute, even with their battle recovery, three of the four Wanderers had already lost close to half of their HP. As for the one Wanderer

who had to go up against three frost swords, his HP had fallen below the 50% mark.

Eventually, before two minutes passed, all four Divine Graveyard Wanderers had lost all of their HP. Then, their bodies transformed into light particles that scattered into the surrounding fog, leaving behind a bunch of weapons and armor pieces. At the same time, Shi Feng also saw his experience bar going up by 26%, showing that the four Heroic Spirits had awarded him an incredibly lucrative amount of EXP.

Although progression will be slow, this gives me time to properly investigate this Ancient God Graveyard, Shi Feng thought to himself with a bitter smile. If it weren't for the Winter of Eternal Night, he would have definitely died to the four Tier 4 Heroic Spirits. Unfortunately, World of Frost only had a three-minute duration, so he couldn't fight another group of Divine Graveyard Wanderers even if he wanted to. He'd have to wait for the Skill's two-hour Cooldown to complete before he could start another fight. In the meantime, he could take his time investigating the Ancient God Graveyard.

After sheathing the Winter of Eternal Night, Shi Feng began inspecting the loot the four Divine Graveyard Wanderers dropped.

An Immortal Equipment Set?

Shi Feng was a little surprised when he saw that the runic weapons and armor that the Wanderers had dropped all radiated a dark-gray glow. Immediately, he used Eyes of Reality to inspect the rank of these Immortal Weapons and Equipment.

The dark-gray glow effect was unique to Immortal Weapons and Equipment, which were also the mainstream equipment in the Greater God's Domain.

Meanwhile, any random Secret-Silver Immortal Equipment Set could be sold for an astronomical price.

Not only did they drop Level 120 Fine-Gold Immortal Equipment Sets, but they've even dropped Dark-Gold Immortal Equipment Sets. Shi Feng was at a loss for words when he finished identifying the equipment the Divine Graveyard Wanderers dropped. *If the Miniature Ancient World's various powers could enter this place, they'd probably faint from joy.*

The four Divine Graveyard Wanderers dropped a total of 14 Fine-Gold Specter Set pieces and three Dark-Gold Blazing Flame Set pieces. This was a considerably high drop rate for Immortal Equipment.

Immortal Weapons and Equipment were incredibly precious in the Greater God's Domain. They were much more durable than ordinary weapons and equipment, which would not only allow players to stay in combat for a much longer time, but also let players save on a hefty sum of repair fees.

In the Greater God's Domain, even Epic Weapons and Equipment could only survive a few fights against Tier 4 Mythic monsters and above. As for weapons and equipment at the Dark-Gold rank or below, it'd be a miracle if they could survive a full fight against a Mythic monster.

Meanwhile, if the durability of weapons and equipment fell to zero during battle, players would be left to fight barehanded and naked. Moreover, players couldn't even get their items repaired afterward, as weapons and equipment would be reduced to nothing but scrap once their durability fell to zero.

Yet, avoiding fights with Mythic monsters and above wasn't an option since monsters of such caliber were everywhere in the Greater God's Domain.

As a result, even though ordinary Epic Weapons and Equipment were very common in the Greater God's Domain, and the cost of repairing items was also significantly cheaper, repair fees remained a significant expense for most players.

Meanwhile, because of the hassle and cost that came with maintaining ordinary weapons and equipment, Immortal Weapons and Equipment became highly sought after in the Greater God's Domain. This was true even for Secret-Silver Immortal Weapons and Equipment. So long as a Secret-Silver Immortal Weapon or Equipment wasn't more than ten levels below the player's level, any player would choose it over ordinary Epic Weapons and Equipment.

Unfortunately, few monsters dropped Immortal Weapons and Equipment, and players mainly had to rely on themselves to craft these items. However, the success rate of producing Immortal Weapons and Equipment at the Secret-Silver rank or above was incredibly low. As a result, even the more inferior Mysterious-Iron Immortal Weapons and Equipment could sell for a higher price than ordinary Epic Weapons and Equipment.

In fact, Immortal Weapons were so rare that Level 150-plus Secret-Silver Immortal Weapons and Equipment could no longer be bought with the

average currencies used for trading. Instead, they would only be traded using the incomparably precious Seven Luminaries Crystals.

Although the Fine-Gold and Dark-Gold Immortal Weapons and Equipment the Divine Graveyard Wanderers dropped could only be used up to Level 120, their value wasn't inferior to that of Level 150 Secret-Silver Immortal Weapons and Equipment in the slightest.

This was because a complete Immortal Equipment Set would generally grant far more Basic Attributes than the average equipment set of the same rank and level. Equipping a complete Immortal Set was akin to wearing an equipment set of a higher level.

As for how big the difference was, a Fine-Gold Immortal Set would grant Basic Attributes that were ten levels higher, while a Dark-Gold Immortal Set would grant Basic Attributes that were 15 levels higher. In other words, a Level 120 Dark-Gold Immortal Set would grant its wearer the Basic Attributes of a Level 135 Dark-Gold Set.

Even a player geared in Level 120 Epic Equipment would be two thresholds behind a player geared in a Level 120 Dark-Gold Immortal Set in terms of Basic Attributes.

If an ordinary expert obtained a Level 120 Dark-Gold Immortal Set, they could use it up to Level 150 without a problem.

The combat environment in the current Miniature Ancient World was essentially the same as the Greater God's Domain already. It was just that monsters in the Miniature Ancient World weren't as powerful. So, while ordinary experts could still barely make do with Fine-Gold and Dark-Gold

Weapons and Equipment, frontline teams were already starting to face great pressure.

The cost of repairing Epic Weapons and Equipment after fighting against several Mythic monsters was a significant expenditure. Currently, a frontline expert would need to spend around 40 Magic Crystals per day on repair fees alone, while a 1,000-man frontline team would have to spend around 40,000 Magic Crystals. This was a frightening expense considering there were very few sources for players to acquire Magic Crystals from in the current Miniature Ancient World. Most of the Magic Crystals in the hands of players still consisted of Magic Crystals brought in by new players.

However, if players could switch to using Immortal Weapons and Equipment, they'd only need to do some simple mana maintenance to keep their gear at 100% effectiveness. In that case, they would, at most, have to spend one or two Magic Crystals a day.

There was a stark contrast between the two.

Not to mention, the Immortal Equipment Sets dropped by the Divine Graveyard Wanderers were far above the average level of current players.

If I wasn't trying to get promoted to Tier 4, I could have made a fortune from this place, Shi Feng thought to himself as he looked at the patrolling Divine Graveyard Wanderers. Then, he quickly avoided these Heroic Spirits and advanced toward locations where he could avoid combat.

Shi Feng only had one opportunity to challenge the Ancient God Graveyard. Different from the leveling maps found in the outside world, so long as he died here, he would not get another chance to return.

Players needed to collect Legacy Power to complete their Tier 4 promotion. The monsters in Legacy Lands were similar to monsters of leveling maps in that they would respawn after a certain period of time. Yet, World of Frost had a long Cooldown of two hours. It'd be unreasonable to try to clear out all of the patrolling Divine Graveyard Wanderers.

So, the wisest move to make now would be to prioritize searching for his Legacy Fragments and collecting enough Legacy Power to complete his Tier 4 promotion. Killing monsters and acquiring loot should only remain as his secondary objectives.

Meanwhile, after Shi Feng had defeated the four Divine Graveyard Wanderers, an obvious blindspot appeared in the Wanderers' patrol route. This allowed Shi Feng to advance without having to worry about getting discovered.

However, for precaution's sake, Shi Feng would still kill four Divine Graveyard Wanderers every two hours, further enlarging the blindspot of the patrolling Wanderers as he progressed deeper into the foggy forest.

However, when Shi Feng moved around 1,000 yards into the graveyard, a pillar of dazzling light suddenly appeared in the distance. Following it, a frightening Divine Might swept over Shi Feng and alarmed his instincts, causing him to stumble backward by several steps.

After taking a moment to calm himself, Shi Feng returned to his previous position. Then, he cautiously observed the distant light while analyzing the Divine Might enveloping him.

Any Legacy or possession from an Ancient God could cause countless Tier 6 God-ranked experts to fight for it crazily. Even the Greater God's Domain's apex powers would spare nothing at getting their hands on an Ancient God's Legacy or possession.

As for the remains of Ancient Gods, Shi Feng had never seen or heard of anyone coming across one before in the Greater God's Domain. In fact, coming across an Ancient God's remains was something no player would ever dare to dream of.

This was because even the remains of ordinary Gods could already offer heaven-defying effects to players.

Out of the various uses a God's remains had, the most widely known usage would be to help players reach Tier 6. This was a feat not even God Legacies could accomplish.

Only, using a God's remains to help players reach Tier 6 was an incredibly extravagant action, so much so that not even the Greater God's Domain's apex powers would be willing to do so.

Rather than that, it'd be much more worthwhile to use a Tier 6 God's remains to forge Legendary Weapons and Equipment or higher. Of course, this was also considered a wasteful way of using a Tier 6 God's remains.

Meanwhile, the method that was publicly known and acknowledged to be the best way of using a God's remains would be to upgrade a God's Domain's rank. Once a God's Domain received a rank-up, not only would the world become stronger as a whole, but it would also become richer in resources and mana.

Take the many Intermediate and Higher God's Domains that existed in the Greater World, for example. Many Tier 6 Gods were killed to upgrade these God's Domains to their current states.

As for an Ancient God's remains?

Shi Feng couldn't even begin to imagine what kind of heaven-defying effects it could have.

After taking a deep breath, Shi Feng quietly observed the Divine Graveyard Wanderers within his view. A moment later, a bitter smile formed on his face as he thought, *Is the system putting the Ancient God's Arm there just for me to admire?*

The Blazing Flame Set might only be a Level 120 Dark-Gold Immortal Set. However, so long as he could complete the eight-piece set, he'd have a Level 135 Dark-Gold Equipment Set at his disposal. At that time, he should be able to suppress the Divine Graveyard Wanderers even without the help of Bronze Combat Techniques.

Thinking up to this point, Shi Feng promptly retreated from his current location and began harvesting the lives of the Divine Graveyard Wanderers that moved in groups of three to five. Although opportunities to strike at these grouped Wanderers didn't come by very often, Shi Feng still managed to find four opportunities to strike after laying in wait for half a day.

Unfortunately, even after killing 14 Divine Graveyard Wanderers and obtaining over 40 Specter Set pieces and 11 Blazing Flame Set pieces, Shi Feng was still missing the Blazing Flame Set's headpiece...

"Guild Leader, I don't know what happened to the Flower of Seven Sins, but it has suddenly started recruiting the younger generation's geniuses without any regard for costs. The Flower of Seven Sins is accepting all Refinement Realm experts under 22 as its core members. Moreover, it is offering all core members the privilege of buying three bottles of S-rank Nutrient Fluid every year," Su Qianliu said anxiously as she looked at Shi Feng through their video call. "Many of Asura's and Zero Wing's geniuses have already shown signs of flocking to the Flower of Seven Sins. If we don't do something about this now, it's only a matter of time before they make up their minds and leave. Should we loosen the conditions to use the Primordial Tower's second floor?"

Geniuses of the younger generation might not be able to become useful combatants right away, but they represented the future of a power. If Zero Wing allowed the Flower of Seven Sins to steal all of its young geniuses, Zero Wing's aim of expanding a development would vanish like a dream.

“Three bottles per person? How generous of them.”

Shi Feng was quite surprised when he heard Su Qianliu's report. Typically, the various superpowers would only offer the peak geniuses they recruited the privilege of purchasing two or three bottles of S-rank Nutrient Fluids per year. If Zero Wing wanted to compete with the Flower of Seven Sins in resources, he'd first have to become an official member of the Star Lake Legion. Then, he'd need to complete quests that awarded a large amount of Star Coins. Before that, there was no way Zero Wing could afford to compete against the Flower of Seven Sins when it came to giving away S-rank Nutrient Fluids.

After listening to Shi Feng's command, Su Qianliu promptly left to carry it out.

The privilege of exchanging for one bottle of S-rank Nutrient Fluid might not be comparable to what the Flower of Seven Sins was offering its core members. However, it was still much better than what the other superpowers offered to their core members.

As for how many of Zero Wing's core members would choose to stay, that would be up to luck.

I can't afford to waste any more time here.

After ending his call with Su Qianliu, Shi Feng quickly finished the premium nutritious meal the God's Domain Association delivered to him daily and logged back into God's Domain. If he wanted Zero Wing to compete with the Flower of Seven Sins and the Greater God's Domain's various powers in training resources, he would have to join the Star Lake Legion and receive official participant status as soon as possible.

A Tier 4 Ultimate Legacy Skill? Shi Feng was stunned by the system notifications.

Tier 4 Legacy Skills could be categorized into four ranks: Basic, Advanced, Peak, and Apex.

Among the many players in God's Domain, the average Tier 6 God-ranked expert would generally receive the option of one or two Peak Legacy Skills when they were challenging their Tier 4 promotion, with the rest of their options being Advanced Legacy Skills. So long as a player completed their Tier 4 promotion with a Peak Legacy Skill, they could hold their ground

against a Superior Mythic monster of the same level, even if they were only equipped in Epic Weapons and Equipment.

As for Tier 4 Apex Legacy Skills, these were incredibly powerful Skills that, when mastered, could allow players to essentially become invincible among players of the same tier. However, players who could receive the privilege of learning one during their Tier 4 promotion were exceedingly rare even in the Greater God's Domain, and those who could complete their Tier 4 promotion with one were even rarer.

Yet, now, two out of the three options Shi Feng had received were Tier 4 Apex Legacy Skills.

As for Tier 4 Ultimate Legacy Skills, Shi Feng had never even heard of Legacy Skills having such a rank.

Mana. You are simply prolonging your suffering. Do not think even for a moment that you can leave this place alive.”

As soon as Tia Pollena finished speaking, several dozen magic arrays suddenly appeared around her. Every one of these magic arrays was formed using divine runes and radiated an ancient and sacred Divine Might. Then, a moment later, several dozen six-winged Valkyries emerged from these ancient magic arrays.

Are you kidding me?

Shi Feng’s excited mood instantly fell to rock bottom when he saw the six-winged Valkyries that filled the sky.

These six-winged Tier 4 Valkyries might not be as strong as Tia Pollena, an eight-winged Tier 4 Valkyrie, but a force of several dozen of them was enough to erase an ancient empire that ruled over several hundred cities. There was no way a Tier 4 player like himself could go up against such a force.

“Disappear from this land!” Tia Pollena shouted as she swung an arm forward.

Immediately, the six-winged Valkyries began launching lightning spears at Shi Feng one after another, blotting out the sky with hundreds of lightning spears in the blink of an eye. Every one of these spears carried power at the Tier 5 Basic standard, and even a Tier 5 expert would have to flee in the face of hundreds of such attacks.

Now that I’ve completed my Tier 4 promotion, all I need to do is get out of the range of the Ancient God’s Arm’s Divine Might, and I should be able to leave

If he were still a Tier 3 player, he would have died instantly to the several dozen six-winged Valkyries.

However, he had completed his promotion already. He was no longer a Tier 3 Sword King but rather a bona fide Tier 4 Sword Emperor. Moreover, he was a Sword Emperor who had formed his Mana Body's core with an Ultimate Legacy Skill. He was superior to even players with Tier 4 Peak Classes.

If comparing purely in terms of Basic Attributes, he already rivaled Superior Mythic monsters of the same level. After factoring in the bonuses he received from Abyssal Power, his Strength and Agility had already reached the Tier 5 threshold. There was also his mana that had reached the Tier 5 standard.

So long as he focused entirely on escaping, even a force of several dozen six-winged Valkyries would need some time to kill him.

Subsequently, Shi Feng could be seen dodging the descending lightning spears one after another. As if he were the moon's reflection on a lake, no matter how many lightning spears rained down on him, none of them

Now that he had gotten promoted to Tier 4, his Concentration had undergone another qualitative transformation.

Now, not only could he manipulate his body much more easily, but he could also manipulate the mana around him with much greater ease and precision.

If his previous control over ambient mana was akin to moving a rock to his desired destination, his current control over ambient mana was akin to moving a piece of cotton; he could freely move it around while exerting little to no effort. Even manipulating his own mana, which had already taken on a solid state, required hardly any effort.

This was also why Shi Feng could easily and rapidly disrupt the lightning spears' flight trajectory by changing the density of the mana around him.
