Why did he say that? At first glance, it didn’t seem that easy to raise. After all, from the skill description, if he wanted to increase his efficiency to the maximum, he would definitely have to feed him heavenly treasures. However, were heavenly treasures really that easy to find?

It was really easy to find!

Liao Zixuan had already verified this from the creation of Planet Annihilation. As long as he could make good use of the players, the largest organization in the world, no matter how many treasures he had, wouldn’t he be able to get them easily?

As for the skills and specialties of “Limitless Body” and “Yamata (Mutation)”, there was no need to talk about them. This was the value of being a member of the [Forbidden Club].

The thing that would really make the little wolf cub cry was Snake Snake’s “Devouring Realm Phantom-Divine Ascension” active skill.

The literal description of the skill seemed quite complicated, but after actually understanding it, one would realize that it was actually very simple.

It was like letting a retired veteran temporarily borrow the peak body of his “past” youth.

Or, he could let a monster that had yet to fully develop fast-forward and temporarily borrow its “future” adulthood, or even the powerful body of a mature beast.

The notes for the last few skills were probably to say that, for example, for a Wisdom Scholar, his “strongest form” was not determined when he was young and strong, but when he was old and had gone through many vicissitudes and read a lot of books.

As for the search span limit, it referred to the gap between the target and Meow.

For example, for an Extraordinary cub, Merv could search up to 200 years before and after, but for a Forbidden cub, he could only search up to 100 years before and after.

Of course, Liao Zixuan was only giving an example of a hundred years or two. As for how long it would take, that would depend on Merv himself.

However, even for forbidden monsters, Meow could only search for them for a year...No, even if it was half a year, Liao Zixuan felt that it was enough.

For ordinary forbidden monsters, even if half a year was enough, a year was nothing. Their strength wouldn’t change much. After all, the cycle of forbidden monsters was measured in ten years, and the later it was, the longer it would be measured in hundreds.

But... It was just an “ordinary” forbidden monster.

The real forbidden monsters had gone from level 15 “infant” to level 50 “mature” in less than half a year.

Liao Zixuan felt that at his current speed, if Meowu could really summon a body of his that would appear in “half a year later”...

Two words.

Invincible.
