Linette felt like she was riding on horseback as Vaan shortly lifted her and continued thrusting deep inside her, rocking her silly.


It felt rough, and it felt wild, but she loved every bit of it.


"Don't stop~!"

Lillias uttered before she quickly stopped by Linette again.


"Don't say anymore," Linette said to her sister before returning her attention to Vaan. "I understand. What will you teach me, Vaan?"
