To use these two metals effectively, they must correspond with their respective school of wizards, or their special effects cannot be utilized.

The final category is the rare, non-attribute extraordinary metal.

Rumors say he is the descendant of a legendary wizard, but it's unclear who exactly.

Levi actually thinks these people are highly likely all legendary wizard reincarnations.

Ordinary wizards would not dare randomly attempt the dual cultivation path, even if they are the children of legends.

Overall, the only variable in Levi exchanging for the Ice Emperor's Throne should be the Ice Sea Witch.

Judging by her war merit, if not squandered, she is entirely likely to exchange the Ice Emperor's Throne immediately.

In the following days, Levi constantly watched the exchange store.

As long as a Level 9 Demon doesn't ambush, the current defense system can hold until official reinforcements arrive.

As Levi makes his return, the Ninth-level Demon Slaying List starts moving.

Wizards know that man has returned.

Previously, in a very short time, he ascended to the top of the list, and dominated it until he advanced to eight rings.

This time, will he be able to recreate his past glory?

The gold content of the Ninth-level Demon Slaying List far surpasses the eighth level.

This is the stage of the most dazzling individuals in the Wizard World before achieving Grand Wizard status.

They are the commanders of the official ace battle group, leaders of top wizard organizations, or scions of some prominent figures.

This is the stage for the prodigies.
